- 2 Insert the included ATI Installation CD into your CD-ROM drive.
- 3 Click the Remote Wonder™ icon on the ATI CD Install screen. Follow the on-screen instructions, and then allow the computer to restart.
- 4 Plug the remote receiver into any available USB port on your computer. The Remote WonderTM Plus icon will appear on the Windows taskbar. Your Remote WonderTM Plus is ready to use!

The Remote WonderTM Plus operates at 433 MHz. The Remote WonderTM Plus range depends upon the environment. For best results, the receiver should be placed as far as possible from the computer's case and monitor.


