In order to manage files and play music easily, users can store the files in different directories (directories should be made in advance and stored in the computer). This series of players support the identification of up to 99 root directories.

## 5. Important Recommendations

- “My Domain” Function

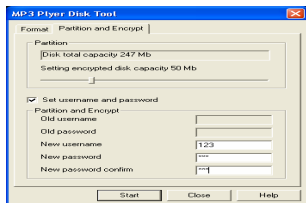
Because beset generally by “data disclosure”, each MP3 user doesn’t like to make personal data seen by others, these “privacies’ has no option but to be deleted when being lent to friends, this will result in many troubles.

From this day onwards, this player provides you with a function of “my domain” to resolve the problem completely. User can partition the USB flash memory into two separate parts using the attached software, (Users can find one disk name on the computer. For another disk name, users need to enter “System Setting/Connecting

Mode” to select “Single Normal Disk” or “Single Encryption Disk”) and encrypt one of them (not necessary to encrypt disk and these two disks can be use separately), therefore the information can be hidden. The information can not be accessed without password. This is the powerful “My Domain” Function connecting the player to the PC.

The steps are as follows:

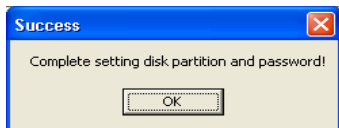
- (1) Run “MP3 Player Disk Tools” software, like the figure on the right:



- (2) Formatting Tool form appears on the screen and select “Partition and Encryption” to set appropriate capacity for the encrypted disk. Then select user name or password.

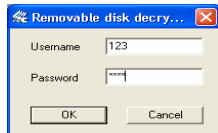
Input user name and password correspondently. Confirm your new password by entering the same password, click “Start” button and start partitioning disk.

- (3) The information below appears after partition finish.



- (4) After pressing “OK” button, a tip comes up for restarting computer, please confirm and restart computer.
- (5) You can find two disks after computer rebooted. (You can find only one disk if use Windows2K Pre-SP4 version). Click the encrypted disk (listed on the second place). Three files appear, two of them are hidden files and the other one is executable file with 300k disk space.

- (6) Run executable file "RdiskDecrypt.exe". Please input user name and password in the window coming up. If the password is correct, you can open the disk and copy file.
- (7) You need to input user name and password to open the encrypted disk each time.



- The player can not identify the files in the encrypted disk.
- Please back up your data before disk partition or disk integration because the data saved on the disk will be clear during these processes.
- Please don't forget your user name and password otherwise you can't use this encrypted disk. The only way to cancel this encrypted disk is to merge two parts, which will result in file lost.

## 6. Trouble Shooting

No Power	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Make sure that the batteries are correctly inserted.</li><li>● Check whether the player is turned on.</li></ul>
Unable to hear sound through earphone	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Make sure that the connection of earphone is correct and the sound volume status is not at 0 point.</li><li>● Keep the earphone clean.</li><li>● The damaged MP3 may cause noise or even can not play music. Please keep these files complete.</li></ul>
Abnormal characters appear on the display	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Make sure to select correct language</li></ul>
Bad FM receiving quality	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Adjust the position between earphone and player</li><li>● Turn off the electric appliance nearby</li><li>● Using earphone as antenna</li></ul>
Unable to download music file properly	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Check whether the USB port is damage and the connection is proper or not.</li><li>● Check whether the USB driver is installed correctly.</li><li>● Check whether the ram space is full or not.</li></ul>
Display shows “ disk error”	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Please use the provided software tool to format player.</li></ul>



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
