TEXT: Switch to Teletex with text mode.

HOLD: Toggle hold on or off for current display page.

**LANG/AUDIO**: To show the list of audio languages available for the current channel.Just in DVB mode/Select AUDIO mode (in DVD mode).

**SUBTITLE**: To switch the dialogue at the bottom of the screen. **INDEX**: Refer to index page.

SIZE: Change display size.

**REVEAL/ANGLE**: Reveal/hidden the hidden words. /No use. **SUBPAGE/ZOOM**: Sub coded page access. /Enlarg or reduces the main picture size (in DVD mode).



#### **Remote Control**

#### Installing the batteries in your remote control

Pull the tab of the back cover and pull up on the cover to open the battery compartment of the remote control.



Insert two AAA size batteries.

Make sure to match the (+) and (-) ends of the batteries with the (+) and (-) ends indicated in the battery compartment.



Align the lower tabs of the back cover to the remote control and snap the cover into place.




#### Note:

Your remote control can be activated from up to the TV 5m away, if pointed directly in front of the device.



# **Using the Features**

#### Watching your TV

If the TV does not display any picture, please check all the connections.



- Press the **POWER** button to turn your TV on.
- Press the **INPUT** button to enter TV mode.
- Press the CH +/- button to change channel number, or use the 0-9 & -/-- buttons to select a channel. The one/two digit numbers can be set by pressing -/-button.
- Press the CD button to alternate back and forth between the current and previous channel.
- Press the **VOL +/-** button to adjust the volume. Press the MUTE button to turn the sound off. Press again to turn the sound on.
- Press the DISPLAY button th display the information such as the channel and channel label.

Note: Select the menu language before operating the TV (see page 15, LANGUAGE).

#### Wide-Screen Mode

Wide-Screen mode allows you watch the broadcasts with various picture format in wide screen mode. Press the ASPECT button repeatedly to toggle through the following wide mode settings.



16:9

When watching 4:3 image, the original image will stretch horizontally to a 16:9 image to fill the screen.



14:9

You can enjoy the picture format of 14:9 or general TV program with the 14:9 mode.



Zoom1


The original image will extend the 1.25:1 image to fill the screen.



4:3

When watching 4:3 image, the original image will be unchanged and there will be vertical bars on the side of the screen.

Press the **ASPECT** button to select repeatedly modes settings as follows:



Note: You can only select 4:3 and 16:9 (Wide) in RGB[PC], HDMI mode only. You can only select 4:3, 16:9 (Wide) and Zoom in RGB[DTV], HDMI[DTV], Component [DTV] mode only.

#### **First Time Installation**



If this is the first time you open the TV and there is no programs in the TV memory, the first time installation menu will appear in the picture.

#### Country


Press ▲/▼ button and then use ◀/▶ to select the country.

#### Language

Press ▲/▼ button and then use ◀/▶ to select the OSD language.


After setting the items, select OK to finish the first timeinstallation, or select Cancel to exit this menu.

You can press LCD-MENU button to stop auto tuning and close the OSD menu. Begin auto tuning in DTV channel.





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#### **PICTURE** menu options

Press MENU button on the front panel or LCD-MENU on the remote control to display the main menu.



- 1. Press **◄/▶** button to select **PICTURE** in the main menu
- 2. Press ▲/▼ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the PICTURE menu.
- 3. Press **◄/▶** button to adjust.
- 4. When you are satisfied with your adjustment, press the **LCD-MENU** button to retun the previous menu or press the **EXIT** button to exit the main menu.

#### **Picture Mode**

Select picture mode in PICTURE menu. (Available picture mode: Standard, Movie, Sport, Mild, Game.) If you change the value of Contrast, Brightness, Colour, Tint, Sharpness or Colour temperature on the picture menu, the picture mode will be changed to "Personal" automatically. You may select the picture mode directly by pressing **PMOD** button.

TIPS: You can press PMOD button on the remote control to select the Picture Mode directly.

#### Contrast

Press  $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$  button and then use  $\blacktriangleleft/\blacktriangleright$  to adjust the contrast of the picture.



After adjusting the value you want, press LCD-MENU button to return to the preview MENU.

#### **Brightness**

Press  $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$  button and then use  $\blacktriangleleft/\blacktriangleright$  to adjust the brightness of the picture.

Press  $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$  button and then use  $\blacktriangleleft/\blacktriangleright$  to adjust the colour saturation.

NOTE: this option is invalid in PC mode, and it will be shown ingray

#### Tint

Press ▲/▼ button and then use ◀/▶ to adjust the tone of colour when your system is in NTSC.

#### **Sharpness**

Press **◄/**▶ to select the sharpness mode of your TV.(Available Sharpend Mode:Normal,Sharp, Sharpest, Softest, Soft.)


#### Colour temperature

Select an optimum colour temperature mode to suit your eyes for viewing among Normal, Warm and Cold.

NOTE: This option is available only in PC mode.

#### **DNR(Digital Noise Reduction)**

If thebroadcast signal received is weak, you can select the DNR option to reduce the video noise level between Off,Low,Mid and High.



#### **SOUND** menu options

Press MENU button on the front panel or LCD-MENU on the remote control to display the main menu.



- 1. Press **◄/▶** button to select **SOUND** in the main menu
- 2. Press ▲/▼ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the SOUND menu.
- 3. Press **◄/▶** button to adjust.
- 4. When you are satisfied with your adjustment, press the **LCD-MENU** button to return the previous menu or press the EXIT button to exit the main menu.

Press  $\triangle/\nabla$  button and then use  $\blacktriangleleft/\triangleright$  to adjust the sound level.



After adjusting the value you want, press LCD-MENU button to return to the preview MENU.

#### **Sound Mode**

Select Sound Mode in SOUND menu. (Available sound mode: Personal, Voice, Music, Theatre.) If you change the value of Bass and Treble on the Sound menu, the sound mode will be changed to "Personal" automatically.

You may select the sound mode directly by pressing **SMODE** button.

TIPS: You can press SMODE button on the remote control to select the Sound Mode directly.

Press ▲/▼ button and then use ◀/▶ to increase or decrease the level of the lower-pitched sounds.

Press ▲/▼ button and then use ◄/▶ to increase or decrease the level of the higher-pitched sounds.

#### Treble

Press ▲/▼ button and then use ◀/► to increase or decrease the level of the audio output between left and right speakers.

#### **SETUP** menu options

Press MENU button on the front panel or LCD-MENU on the remote control to display the main menu.

NOTE:SETUP menus are different for different input sources, if the input source is selected HDMI/ VGA and there are no relative input signal, SETUP menu will be unavailable.

#### **SETPUT** menu of TV input:



- 1. Press **◄/▶** button to select **SETUP** in the main menu
- 2. Press ▲/▼ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the SETUP menu.
- 3. Press **◄/▶** button to adjust.
- 4. When you are satisfied with your adjustment, press the **LCD-MENU** button to retun the previous menu or press the **EXIT** button to exit the main menu.

#### Country

This option allows you to select the country.


#### **Auto Tuning**

This option allows you to tune the channels that can be received automatically.

Note: Before you perform Auto Tuning, you must choose the country where you are by selecting Country option.



#### Press OK key to start.



This option allows you to perform Manual Tuning.

NOTE: Before you perform Manual Tuning, you must choose the country where you are by selecting Country optiom.

- 2. Press ▲/▼ button to perform yor selection,the menu of Manual Tuning will display on the screen.

#### **Program**

The current program number.press **◄/**▶ upper or lower program.

#### **Sound System**

Press **◄/**▶ to select a corresponding sound system, such as I,DK,BG.

#### **Colour System**

Press **◄/▶** to select a corresponding colour system, such as Auto, PAL, SECAM.

#### **Program Label**

This option allows you to label a channel, you can also relabel the programs have been labeled.

- 1. Select a channel you want to labeled.
- 2. Press **◄/▶** to select **Program Labeled** in the **SETUP** menu.
- 3. Press ▲/▼ to perform yor selection,the menu of **Program Label** will display as below.



- 4. Press the numeric buttons to input the numbers directly or press ▲/▼ to select the letters.
- 5. Press **◄/▶** to move the cursor.
- 6. Press **ENTER,LCD-MENU** or **EXIT** button to confirm and return to previous menu.

#### AFT(Auto Fine Tune)

Due to weak signals or a wrong antenna configuration, some of the channels may not be tuned to the best reception condition. AFT function allows you to fine tune channel selected (the frequency of channel is around the value in Manual Search option).

#### **Manual Search**



This option has two functions:

- 1. Set the puency of channel for AFT option.
- 2. Press ▶ button for 3+ seconds and it will start auto tuning from this frepuency.

#### **Program Edit**


This function allows ypu to sort the TV programs according to ypur preferences, as following:



- 1. Press ▲/▼ to select **Program Edit** in the **SETUP** menu.
- 2. Press **◄/▶** to enter into the sub menu,a channel list will display.
- 3. Press ▲/▼ to select the channel in the list which you would like to sort.
- 4. Press ▶ to perform your selection.
- 5. Press ▲/▼ to select the location you would like to place the channel.
- 6. Press ◀ to perform your selection.
- 7. Press **LCD-MENU** to return to the previous menu or press **EXIT** to exit.
- Favorite:Press green button on remote control to select the favourite programs.



Press **FAV** button to open the **Favorite List**, you can open your favourite programs then Press ▲/▼ to select the channel you want to watch.



DSkip:Press yellow button on remote control to select which programs you want to skip. Press yellow button again thes program will unlock.



Favorite: Press blue button on remote control to lock the programs. Press blue button again this program will not be skipped.



#### Timer menu options

Press MENU button on the front panel or LCD-MENU on the remote control to display the main menu.



- 1. Press **◄/▶** button to select **TIMER** in the main menu
- 2. Press ▲/▼ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the **TIMER** menu.
- 3. Press **◄/▶** button to adjust.
- 4. When you are satisfied with your adjustment, press the **LCD-MENU** button to retun the previous menu or press the EXIT button to exit the main menu.

#### **Sleep Timer**

Select the sleep time to put automatically the TV in standby mode. Timer can be selected as 0min, 15min,30min,45min,60min,75min,90min,105min,120min.Also you can select the sleep time by pressing SLEEP button repeatedly.

You can select the time when the OSD display on the screen such as:5sec,10sec,15sec,20sec, 25sec,30sec.

#### Function menu options

Press MENU button on the front panel or LCD-MENU on the remote control to display the main menu.



- 1. Press **◄/▶** button to select **FUNCTION** in the main menu
- 2. Press ▲/▼ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the FUNTION menu.
- 3. Press **◄/▶** button to adjust.
- 4. When you are satisfied with your adjustment, press the **LCD-MENU** button to retun the previous menu or press the EXIT button to exit the main menu.

#### Language

Press **◄/**▶ to select the OSD language.

#### Video Size

This option allows you to select the screen display mode which best corresponds to your viewing requirements.

**NOTE:** The available aspect mode may be different in different input signal.

#### Blue Screen

This option allows you to select the blue background on or off. If on, the screen background will turn blue very weak or no signal condition.

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#### **ATV Menu**

#### Child Lock

Press **ENTER** or ▶ button to set the child lock.

You need to enter the PIN code if the **Child Lock** is set "on", and the default PIN code is empty, you can press **ENTER** button directly to enter.



**TIPS:**The superuser's (administrator's) password is 4711.



#### **Child Lock**

Press **ENTER** or ▶ btton to set the child lock.

#### **Key Lock**

Press **ENTER** or ▶ btton to set the key lock.

#### **Change PIN Code**

Press **ENTER** or ▶ btton to set the Change PIN Code.



#### **Old PIN Code**

Press  $0\sim9$  buttons to enter the correct old PIN code, you can not change the PIN code if you entered a wrong PIN code.

#### **New PIN Code**

Press 0~9 buttons to enter the new PIN code you want.

#### **Enter Again**

Press 0~9 buttons to enter the PIN code you entered in the New PIN Code menu again to confirm the new PIN code.

#### **First Time Installation**

Press ▶ button to open the First Time Installation menu, and the operation of this menu is in page 13.


#### Reset






