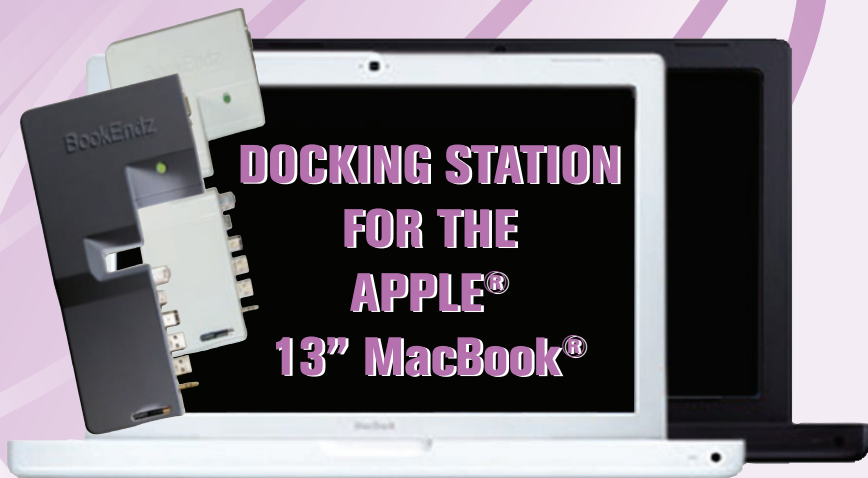

Thank you for purchasing the **BookEndz**[®] Dock for your MacBook[®] Computer. The purpose of the **BookEndz**[®] Dock is to eliminate the hassles, headaches, wear & tear, and delays that arise from having to plug in all of your peripheral cables each time you want to use them. Once the cables are plugged into the dock, all you need to do is slide in your **BookEndz**[®] Dock and you are connected to everything at once.

Prior to using you new **BookEndz**[®] Dock, take a few minutes to read through this manual. It contains important information regarding the use of your new **BookEndz**[®] Dock.

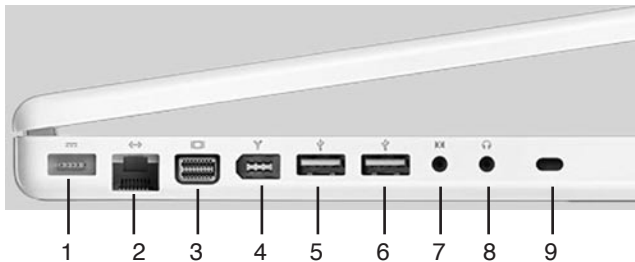

INSTALLING YOUR NEW BookEndz® DOCK

1. Place the **BookEndz** Dock on the flat surface on which it will be used and plug all of your external devices into the **BookEndz** Docking Station (video monitor, network, modem, etc.).
2. Shut down the MacBook and close the LCD screen.
3. Place the MacBook next to the **BookEndz** Dock (with the ports of the MacBook aligning with the connectors of the **BookEndz** Dock). Slowly slide the **BookEndz** Dock into the MacBook.
4. Restart your MacBook and allow your peripheral devices to bootup.
5. To travel with your MacBook, shut down your MacBook and all external devices and close the LCD screen. It is not necessary to unplug them from the dock. Gently pull the dock away from the MacBook and you will be on your way in seconds!

Your 13" DVI MacBook has nine side panel ports and features as shown:

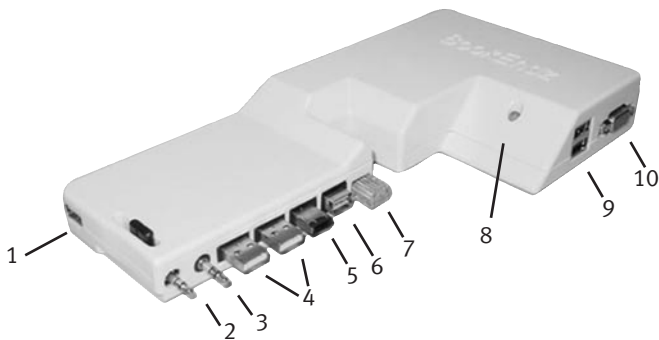

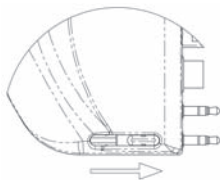

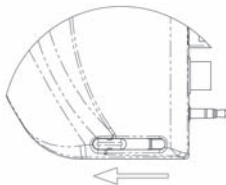
AUDIO HOOKUP

The Headphone Out Connector on your **BookEndz** Dock was designed to allow use of either external speakers or the internal speakers of your MacBook.

To use external speakers, move the Headphone Out Connector to engage into the MacBook:



To use internal speakers, move the Headphone Out Connector to disengage from the MacBook:



SECURITY FOR YOUR MacBook AND BookEndz® DOCK

Since the **BookEndz** Docking Station allows you to remove your MacBook in a matter of seconds, security should be a concern. Security options for your computer include third party solutions, such as the Kensington Slim MicroSaver® Notebook Security Cable.

The MacBook has its own security slot on the left side towards the front of the computer, and the **BookEndz** Dock has a security slot on its left side near the back of the dock. You may wish to secure one or both items while you are away.

Security devices may be connected to the slot(s) on the side of the **BookEndz** Dock and/or the MacBook.

DOCKING AND UNDOCKING YOUR BookEndz® DOCK

Docking your **BookEndz** Dock into the MacBook is simple, quick, and easy. With your MacBook shutdown (not asleep), position the dock on the flat surface you intend to use it on. Align the connectors on the **BookEndz** Dock, with the ports on the MacBook, and gently push the **BookEndz** Dock until docking is complete.



To undock, shutdown the MacBook and all in one motion gently pull the **BookEndz** Docking Station away from your MacBook.



LIMITED WARRANTY

("Manufacturer") warrants this **BookEndz**® product to be free from defects caused by faulty materials or poor workmanship for a period of one year from the date of shipment to the initial user of the product.
