

INSTALLING YOUR NEW BookEndz[®] DOCK

- Place the **BookEndz** Dock on the flat surface on which it will be used and plug all of your external devices into the **BookEndz** Docking Station (video monitor, network, modem, etc.).
- 2. Shut down the MacBook and close the LCD screen.
- 3. Move the release handle to the vertical position. Place the MacBook on to the **BookEndz** Dock. **Make sure that the ports of the MacBook align with the connectors of the BookEndz Dock.** Once those ports are lined up push left hand side of Docking Station into the ports on the laptop.
- 4. Restart your MacBook and allow your peripheral devices to bootup.
- 5. To travel with your MacBook, shut down your MacBook and all external devices and close the LCD screen. It is not necessary to unplug them from the dock. Move the release handle to the vertical position. The **BookEndz** Dock will gently undock from your MacBook.



DOCKING AND UNDOCKING YOUR BookEndz® DOCK

Docking your **BookEndz** Dock into the MacBook is simple, quick, and easy. With your MacBook shutdown (not asleep), position the dock on the flat surface you intend to use it on. Align the connectors on the **BookEndz** Dock, with the ports on the MacBook, and gently push the **BookEndz** Dock until docking is complete.

To undock, shutdown the MacBook and move the release handle to the vertical position. The **BookEndz** Dock will gently undock from your MacBook.
