





《Charging the headset 》(while LED is red)

1 > 2 > 3 > 4 (Check LED status)



《Power on》

Press and hold the $[\triangle]$ button for 4 seconds \triangleright LED flashes blue light for 4 times \triangleright release the $[\triangle]$ button \triangleright power on successful.

(Powering on status is LED flashes one time per several seconds)

《Power off》

Press and hold the $[\triangle]$ button for 4 seconds \triangleright LED flashes red light for 4 times \triangleright release the $[\triangle]$ button \triangleright power off successful.

《Pairing with mobilphone》

Press and hold the $[\triangle]$ button for 7 seconds \triangleright LED flashes blue light for 4 times \triangleright LED flashes red and blue alternatively \triangleright release the $[\triangle]$ button \triangleright follow the mobilphone's manual for pairing \triangleright select "CG-BTHS02" of the listing showed on your mobilphone screen \triangleright type

password, "1234" ➤ pairing successful.

《Make a call》

Dialing by the mobilphone.

《Redial last call》

Press and hold the $[\nabla]$ button for 3 seconds \triangleright starting auto dialing last call.

《Cancel dialing》

Press and release the $[\triangle]$ button \triangleright the call is canceled.

《Voice dialing》

(It depends on mobilphone's voice dialing function)

Press and release the $[\triangle]$ button \triangleright Say the telephone number (or voice tag) \triangleright starting auto dialing.

《Answer a call》

Press and release the $[\triangle]$ button \triangleright start to talk.

《End a call》

Press and hold the $[\nabla]$ button for 3 seconds \blacktriangleright the call is ended.

《Reject a call》

(while phone is ringing)

Press and hold the $[\triangle]$ button for 3 seconds \blacktriangleright the call is rejected.

《Adjust speaker volume》

Press and release the $[\triangle]$ button \blacktriangleright volume up Press and release the $[\nabla]$ button \blacktriangleright volume down

《Transfer/Switch Calls》

(While talking on the headset)

Press and hold $[\triangle]$ button for 3 seconds \blacktriangleright transfer the call to the mobile phone \blacktriangleright press and release $[\triangle]$ button \blacktriangleright transfer the call back to headset.

《Mute the Microphone》

Press and hold both $[\triangle]$ and $[\nabla]$ button for 3 seconds \blacktriangleright mute during a call.

Press and hold both $[\triangle]$ and $[\nabla]$ button \blacktriangleright mute is canceled during a call.

《Connect with a PC or PDA》

You are allowed to connect the headset with a Bluetooth enabled PC or PDA that is with Audio Gateway Profiles supported. Please refer to the user manual of your Bluetooth enabled PC or PDA for a setup information.

There are 2 ways to wear the headset (either right or left side):

《Wearing the headset without ear hook》

1. Directly place the headset into your ear without the ear hook.

《Wearing the headset with a ear hook》

- 1. Buckle the ear hook onto the headset.
- 2. You may bend and adjust the hook to fit your ear, then gently place the ear hook onto your ear. (Figure 2, ex: wearing onto left ear.)
- 3. You may take apart the ear hook and buckle the headset by the contrary way if you want to exchange to the right ear. (Figure 3)






6.1 Charging the headset

The headset comes with an embedded rechargeable battery. For first time use, it should takes about 4 hours to fully charge the battery. Afterward, it takes about 2 hours to fully charge. With battery fully charged, the talk time is about 6 hours, and the standby time will be about 160 hours.

- Connect the DC Jack Connector with transferred connector as picture shown below.
- Connect the other side of transferred connector to the rechargeable port of the headset.
- 3. Plug the charger into the socket of the power supply.
- 4. Both red and green LEDs of transferred connector will light up.



* Note:

- When the red indicator of the headset starts to flash, it indicates that the headset is running low on battery. Charge the headset for 2 hours until the red indicator turns off.
- 2. The headset doesn't work while charging.

6.2 Power On/Off the headset

《Power On》

Press and hold $[\triangle]$ button for 4 seconds. While you see the LED flashes blue light for 4 times and hear two short high tones, release $[\triangle]$ button, then it will be powered on.

《Power Off》

Press and hold $[\triangle]$ button for 4 seconds. While you see the LED flashes red light for 4 times and hear two low tones, release $[\triangle]$ button, then it will be powered off.

6.3 Pairing

You are required to pair the headset with your mobile phone or other devices before using it.

- 1. The headset must be powered off before initiating pairing. To initiate pairing, press and hold $[\triangle]$ button for 7 seconds until the blue and red indicators of headset are flashing alternatively. If you are wearing the headset during the pairing process, you will hear two short high tones when the headset is ready for pairing.
- 2. Initiate pairing process of your mobile phone. Refer to the manual of mobile phone for detail process. You will see a new item "CG-BTHS02" added in your Bluetooth device list after searching process.
- 3. You will be asked to enter pin-code to complete pairing. Please enter [1234] and confirm it.

* Note:

- 1. [1234] is the default pin-code.
- The red indicator of headset will turn off and the blue indicator will flash slowly after pairing completed successfully.
- If the headset is not in pairing mode, your mobile phone won't find the headset. Please set the headset on pairing mode before the mobile phone search for the headset.
- 4. If no pairing is possible for a period of time (approx. two minutes), the headset will automatically power off, and so the previous pairing (if any) is revoked. You may need to repeat steps 1 to 3 until pairing succeeds.

6.4 Making Calls

Dial the number on the mobile phone as you usually do.

6.5 Redial

Press and hold $[\nabla]$ button for 3 seconds to redial the last number you called.

6.6 Voice Dialing

Press $[\triangle]$ button, waiting for a beep from headset and say the voice tag or the name of the person you want to call. Press $[\triangle]$ button again to cancel voice dialing.

* Note: It depens on the mobile phone which supports the function. And the name you said has been to saved as a voice tag in mobile phone contact listing.

6.7 Answering a call

When the headset is powered on and the mobile phone rings, you will hear a musical tone and the blue indicator will change to be quick flashing. Press $[\triangle]$ button to answer the call.

* Note: Due to the different design of some mobile phones, an auto-disconnect may happen even when the headset is powered on. In that case, the headset won't ring when there is an incoming call. Press and release the $[\triangle]$ button to reconnect the headset with mobile phone for an incoming call.

6.8 End a call

End calls by pressing and holding $[\nabla]$ button for 3 seconds or do nothing.

6.9 Reject a call

Press and hold $[\triangle]$ button for 3 seconds to reject a call.

6.10 Transfer/Switch Calls

Press and hold $[\triangle]$ button for 3 seconds to transfer the call to mobile phone while talking on the headset. If you want to transfer the call back to headset, press $[\triangle]$ button again.

6.11 Adjust the headset Volume

Press $[\triangle]$ button for volume up or press $[\nabla]$ button for volume down.

6.12 Mute

Press both $[\triangle]$ and $[\nabla]$ buttons in the same time for a Mute function. Press both $[\triangle]$ and $[\nabla]$ buttons in the same time again to disable the Mute function.

6.13 Connect with a PC or PDA

You are allowed to connect the headset with a Bluetooth enabled PC or PDA that is with Audio Gateway Profiles supported. Please refer to the user manual of your Bluetooth enabled PC or PDA for a setup information.

FAQ

- Q1. Why doesn't the headset work with my mobile phone after the headset has been fully charged and switched on?
- Ans: You have to activate the Bluetooth function of your mobile phone first and pair it with the headset.
- Q2. Does the headset work with all types of mobile phones? Ans: No. It works only with Bluetooth enabled mobile phones.
- Q3. What is the operation distance between the headset and a Bluetooth mobile phone?
- Ans:The maximum operation distance can be up to 10 meters, however it will be affected and shortened by different circumstances and different brands of mobile phones. Some mobile phones are with less operative distance.
- Q4. When my mobile phone was searching for the headset, why did several Bluetooth devices appear on my mobile phone?
- Ans: Most Bluetooth enabled mobile phones with Bluetooth function activated can search for more than one Bluetooth device within operative range. The headset will appear as "CG-BTHS02" on your mobile phone after having been found by your mobile phone.
- Q5. Why can't my mobile phone find the headset?
- Ans: If the headset is not in pairing mode, your mobile phone won't find the headset. Please set the headset into pairing mode before starting your mobile phone to search for the headset. (Please refer to the User Manual for detailed instructions.)
- Q6. Do I need to pair the headset with my mobile phone every time I use it?
- Ans: No, once the Pairing is set up between the two devices, they will remain paired even when one or both devices are powered off.
- Q7. Why is there a disturbance noise coming from the headset?

 Ans: Whether your mobile phone is in a good signal area. If your mobile phone is in weak signal area, you won't hear clearly with the headset.

Q8. What should I do when I can't hear very well with the headset? Ans: Adjust the sound volume on your mobile phone, or press the $[\triangle]$ button of the headset to make volume up, or check if your mobile phone is in a good signal area.

Q9. Why doesn't the headset work suddenly? Ans:

- 1) The headset may have run out of battery. When it is in low battery, a red LED will start to flash.
- 2) Some Bluetooth mobile phones have a problem with the Bluetooth implementation, will occasionally but not often, get into an Bluetooth shut-down status in unpredictable circumstances. When this happens, please restart your mobile phone. (It is not necessary to perform Pairing again.)

Make sure that your phone has the latest version of firmware loaded onto it. Please check the website of your mobile phone for new firmware.

Q10. Why doesn't the voice dialing function work with the headset?

Ans: You may have to record the voice tag with the headset to your mobile phone. So that it can make sure the voice or number you said is right to correspond with the voice tag.
