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# Pre-Construction Wall Mount Back Box: BB-6X-DSW

## **Description**

The Crestron® BB-6X-DSW back box provides a UL®-listed, recess-mounted steel enclosure for the TPS-6X-DSW Wall Mount Docking Station. Designed for preconstruction applications, the BB-6X-DSW permits fastening to the left or right side of a stud in a framed wall prior to installation of sheet rock. Conduit knockouts are provided on the top and bottom to accommodate a variety of fittings and a blank cover plate is included.

**NOTE:** If mounting into a material other than drywall (for example, wood lectern, concrete or rock) use the cutout template, available in the post-construction kit MMK-6X-DSW or TMK-6X-DSW.

**NOTE:** For concrete and rock mounting material, allow for proper ventilation before mounting the TPS-6X-DSW.






BB-6X-DSW Mounted View (Optional Cover Plate Attached)




The dimensions of the BB-6X-DSW are shown in the following illustration.

#### BB-6X-DSW Overall Dimensions (Front View)






#### BB-6X-DSW Overall Dimensions (Bottom View)



**NOTE:** Knockout holes are intended for Class 2 wiring only and are ½" and ¾" diameter.

### Setup

#### **Assembly**

#### **Required Tools:**

• #2 Phillips tip screwdriver

The back box mounting enclosure comes fully assembled except for a grounding screw. To prepare for mounting, complete the following procedure:

- 1. Remove knockouts as required.
- 2. Attach the supplied #08-8B self-tapping screw to back box mounting enclosure assembly for grounding.

**NOTE:** The #08-8B self-tapping screw (2007277), supplied for grounding purposes, is installed in the rear of the back box mounting enclosure assembly.

#### Mounting

#### **Required Tools and Materials:**

- #2 Phillips tip screwdriver
- Level
- Standard drywall screws or nails (not included)


CAUTION: Allow an air gap of a least 12 inches (30.48 cm) in the wall cavity above and below the TPS-6X-DSW for heat dissipation.

**NOTE:** If your installation is not on wooden studs, be sure to consider the needs of your particular situation. For example, screw type may vary for steel studs, etc.


To mount the back box, complete the following procedure (refer to illustration on the following page).

- 1. Position the back box against the stud so the extended edge of the attached mounting plate covers the front edge of the stud. Be sure the side of the back box is also against the side of the stud.
- 2. Use the level and verify the back box is horizontal. Leveling must be done before proceeding.
- 3. Attach the back box to the left or right side of the stud with standard drywall screws or nails (not included). If mounting to the left side of a stud, the back box must be turned over so the extended edge of the attached mounting plate is on the right side.
- 4. Feed cables through the knockout holes.

**NOTE:** This assembly should use Class 2 wiring only.



Mounted View with Cover Plate (Mounting Example Prior to Drywall Installation)




**NOTE:** Cut the drywall to the inside edge of the front of the back box. The labels on the front of the back box indicate the perimeter of the opening that should be cut out.

**NOTE:** The four tapped holes on the front of the back box must be exposed to accept the TPS-6X-DSW mounting screws. The holes are found beneath the drywall just outside of the four corners of the opening made by cutting out the drywall. Refer to the **NOTE** in "Mounted View with Cover Plate" above.

#### Installation

Complete the installation by either installing the TPS-6X-DSW, leaving the hole open (if permitted by local building codes) or installing the optional cover plate with the included  $\#06-32 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$  screws, as shown in the illustration above.

If the TPS-6X-DSW is to be installed, refer to the latest revision of the TPS-6X-DSW Operations & Installation Guide (Doc. 6708) for installation instructions. ### **Other Mounting Option Accessories**

If too much of the mounting plate is exposed after the drywall is cut, you may need to patch the area. Crestron provides the following accessories:

- MMK-6X-DSW (Doc. 6779) for larger repairs and to fill in larger irregularities around the opening (requires plastering).
- TMK-6X-DSW (Doc. 6780) for smaller repairs and to provide a smooth edge at the opening. This option provides a finished appearance and is preferred when wallpaper is hung.

  and request an RMA (Return Merchandise Authorization) number. Enclose a note specifying

Authorized returns must be shipped freight prepaid to CRESTRON, 6 Volvo Drive, Rockleigh, N.J. or its authorized subsidiaries, with RMA number clearly marked on the outside of all cartons. Shipments arriving freight collect or without an RMA number shall be subject to refusal. CRESTRON reserves the right in its sole and absolute discretion to charge a 15% restocking fee plus shipping costs on any products returned with an RMA.
- Return freight charges following repair of items under warranty shall be paid by CRESTRON, shipping by standard ground carrier. In the event repairs are found to be non-warranty, return freight costs shall be paid by the purchaser.

#### **CRESTRON Limited Warranty**
