- When you place this player near strong magnetic materials, it may affect image or voice poorly or damage recording.
- Do not spill volatile liquids like insect spray over the player. Do not leave rubber or plastic products in contact with the player for a long time. They will cause deterioration or paint to peel-off.

✓ Not in use

- When the unit is not in use, be sure to remove the disc or tape and turn off the power.
- If you do not use the unit for a long period, remove batteries in remote control to prevent leakage.
- In case you don't use the unit for a long time, the unit may not function properly in the future. Turn on and use the player occasionally.

✓ Moving

- Repack the unit as it was originally packed at the factory. Alternatively, pack this product with towel not to be damaged.

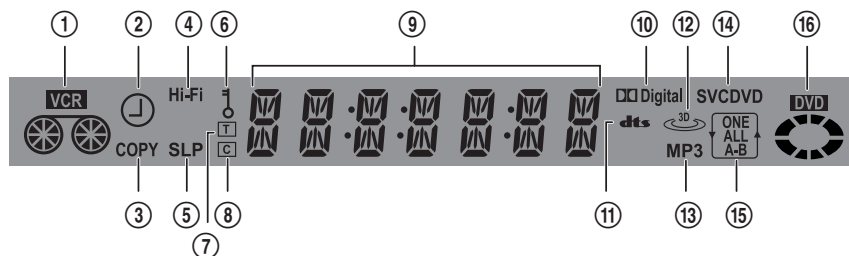

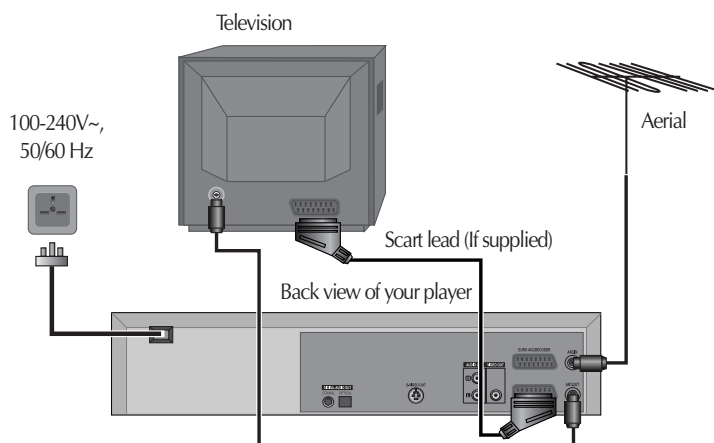
Setting up your player

- Before you start, unplug all the equipment from the mains supply.

● (Option 1) - Connecting your player through RF lead



● (Option 2) - Connecting your player through a scart lead

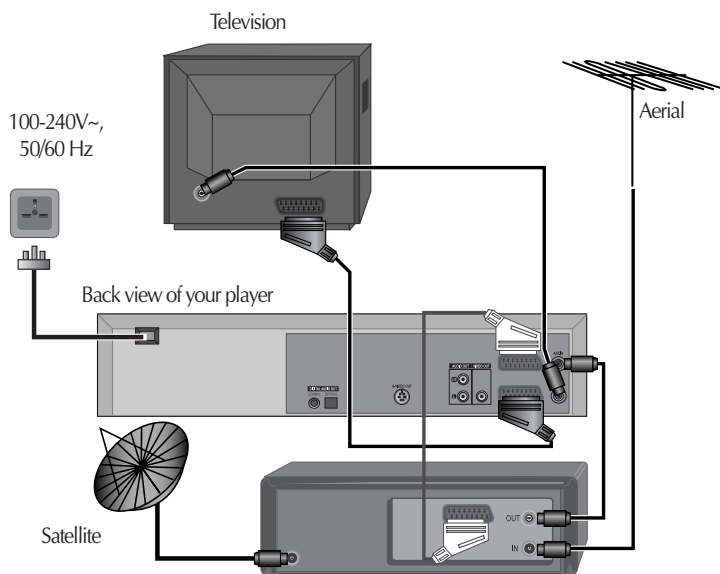


With this connection, if your player is receiving CH ARD and your TV is displaying CH3, when you press the [TV/VCR] button on the remote control, your TV will automatically display the CH ARD. "VCR" will be displayed. In this mode, to change the viewing channels the [PR-] and [PR+] buttons on the player remote need to be used. To switch off this mode press [TV/VCR] on the remote control, TV remote can now be used as normal. You will get better pictures and sound quality if you connect your player with a scart lead.

Connecting your player through extra equipment (satellite system)

■ Before you start, unplug all the equipment from the mains supply.

● (Option 1) - Connecting your player through RF lead

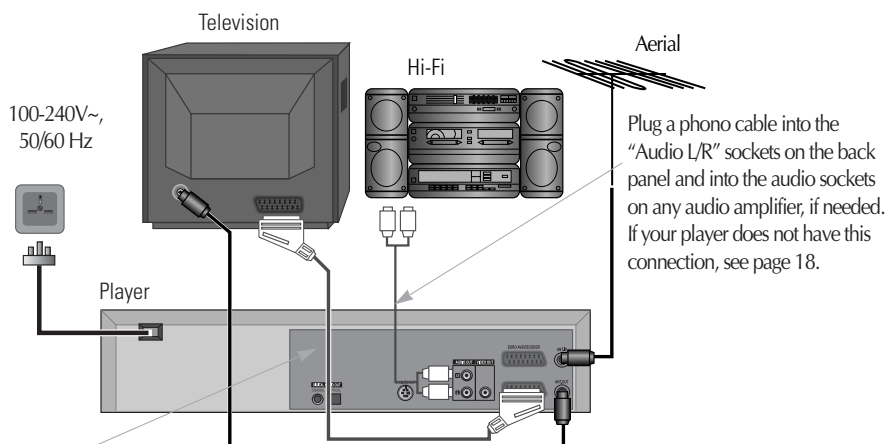


You can use this connection if your player has two scart sockets. This will improve sound and picture quality when you are recording from satellite.

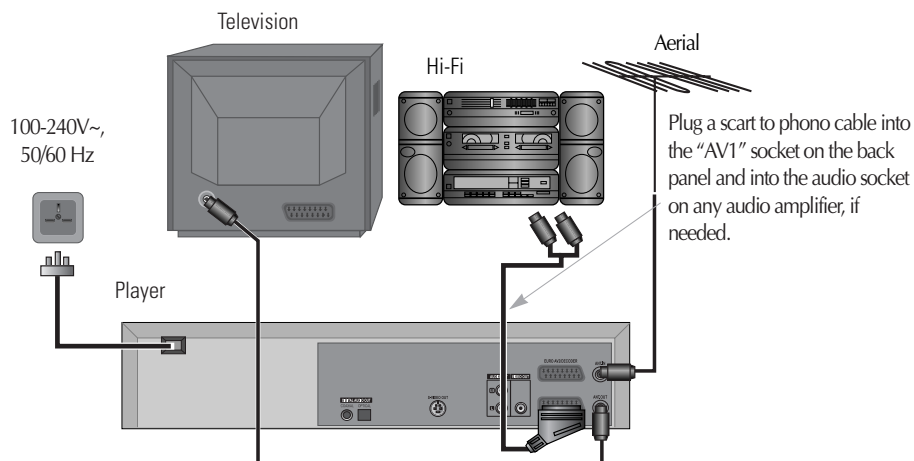

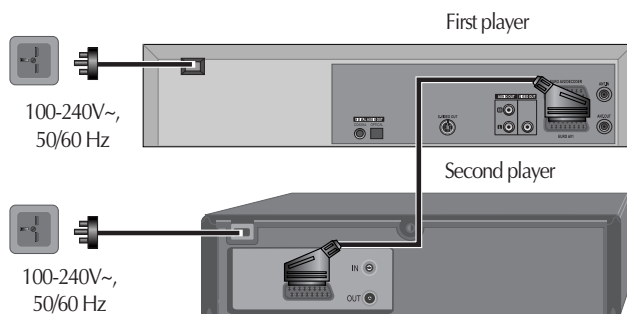

- 3) Press the [RECORD] button on the first player.

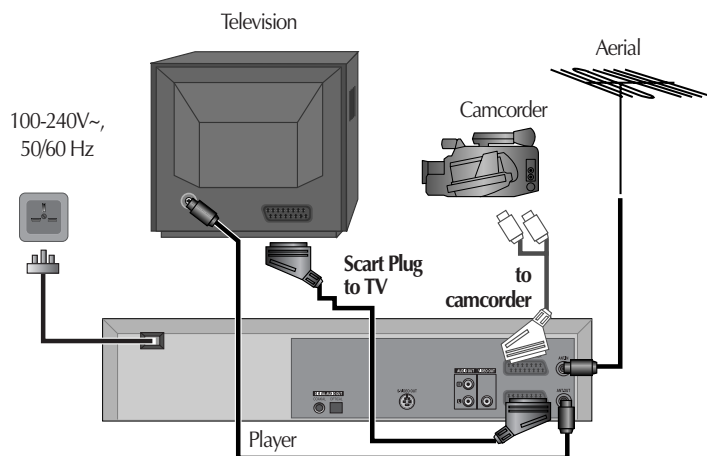
The player will start recording.

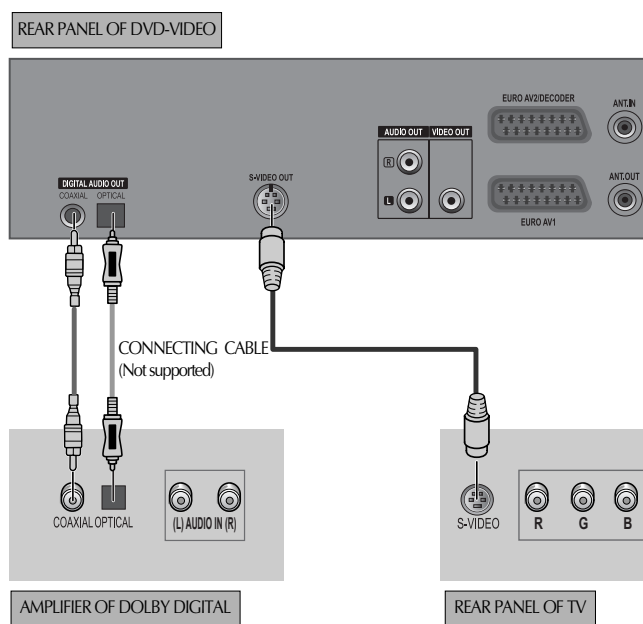

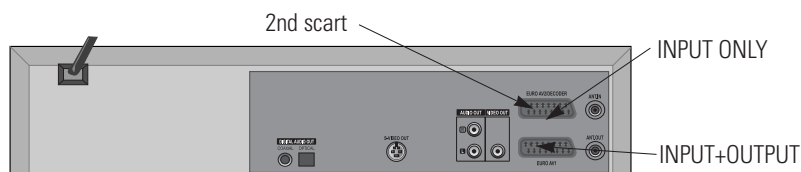

If your video has the AV2 output, shown in the diagram below, you can connect other equipment as seen on pages 17-20.



When connecting other equipment please refer to their manuals for further information. This video manual recommends the set up as shown on page 17. When connected by this method if the equipment is turned off the video behaves as normal, but if the equipment is turned on the video will automatically switch over to AV2 mode and displays the channel of the other equipment, channel selection can only be performed by the other equipment, the video PR+/PR- buttons have no effect.

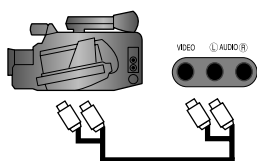
To return to normal video use the other equipment must be turned off.

Recording from other Equipment.

Simple recording can be performed, ensure the equipment is turned on and is displaying the correct channel.

Timer recording, set the video to perform a timed recording ensuring AV1 is selected as the channel to be recorded.

Some equipment may have a timer which allows it to be powered on to the correct channel, if this feature is not available the other equipment should be left powered on.



Front AV

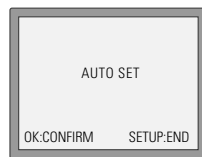
If the video has front input sockets, it is possible to connect devices such as a camcorder to the video. To watch a camcorder tape the video must be in AVF mode. Recordings of this input are the same as described on page 20.

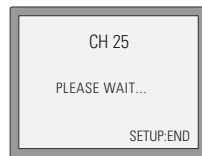

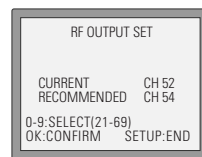

Clock is automatically set.

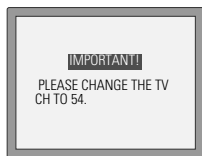


3 If other stations are positioned on or near the current RF OUTPUT CH, the guide message appears automatically.



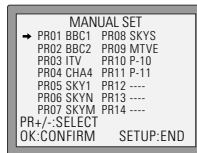

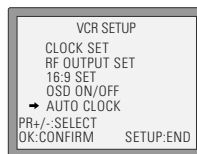

Auto Clock

- Auto Clock is only available for models with the PDC function (see page 36). Some broadcasting stations may send the time and date along with the PDC data. The video will automatically use this time and date during the initial setting up procedure during normal use, and every time you switch the video off at the mains. If you find that this time and date is incorrect you can remove this feature by following the steps below changing it to OFF mode, you will then have to manually set the time and date, see page 25.

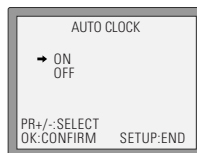

Select a Dynamic Range.

Dynamic range can differs by users and their watching environment. High-density audio programs like movies have wide dynamic range. In the dynamic range, explosion sounds 20dB higher and rustle of leaves sounds 50dB less than conversation. Sometimes, depending on watching environment, loud sound should be heard louder while soft sound should be heard softer. Likewise, very soft sound is not audible and viewers should raise the sound level.

This unit is designed and manufactured to respond to the Region Management information that is recorded on a DVD disc. The region number of this player is "2". If the region number described on the DVD discs does not correspond to the Region number of this player, the player will not play this disc. This player will play DVD discs made for "ALL" regions. Therefore, this player will play DVD discs marked with labels containing the region number "2" or "ALL".

Terms related with DVD

DVD	A DVD (abbreviation of Digital Versatile Disc or Digital Video Disc) can include 135 minutes of video information. And for audio, it can hold up to 8 kinds of languages and 32 kinds of subtitle languages. By using MPEG-2 video compression and digital 3D surround sound, DVD realises high-defined screen and quality sound like a movie theatre.
CDDA	A CDDA (abbreviation of Compact disc digital audio) is a music disc that is currently used.
MP3	Audio compression format that enables audio files to be stored and transferred on a computer with a relatively small file size. It enables you to enjoy CD quality music. (Short for MPEG-1 Layer 3)
PBC	This is recorded on a Video CD 2.0, Video CD 3.0, SVCD and VCD. The scenes or information to be viewed (or listened to) can be selected interactively with the TV monitor by looking at the menu shown on the TV monitor. It stands for PlayBack Control.
CHAPTER	It means the information recorded in a DVD. A title in a DVD is divided into many tracks, of which a track is called as a chapter. A certain scene of a screen can be quickly searched with the chapter number.
TITLE	It means the information recorded in a DVD. A DVD can be divided into many titles.
TRACK	It means the information recorded in a video CD and audio CD. A disc consists of many a track, for which a user can search a certain position.
dts	Digital Theatre System is a 5.1 -channel surround sound system, which is widely used in movie theatres around the world. It enables the bit rate to be increased to provide good sound quality.
Multi Angle	Some DVD discs contain the various scenes that have been simultaneously shot from a number of different angles.
PCM	Linear PCM is a signal-recording format used in a CD, while CD is recorded in 44.1kHz/16bit, a DVD is recorded in 48KHz/16bit up to 96KHz/24bit.
Dolby Digital	Dolby Digital is a system maximized surround sound from the reform of the existing 4 channel Pro-Logic. Basically the system consists of 5 channels of a centre speaker, L & R speakers and L & R rear speakers. Dolby Digital adds a sub-speaker to the above system in order to reinforce sub-woofer.
Bitstream	A series of data streams not decoded by Dolby Digital decoders or dts decoders. To use bitstream, you require an amplifier with a built in Dolby Digital or dts decoder.
Lt/Rt	It indicates L/R of Dolby Digital 2CH Downmix output.

Downmix DOWNMIX is reproducing the proper audio when audio format recorded on a disc differs from the output audio channel configuration. For example, with just one stereo speaker system you can hear full 5.1 channel audio.

S-VIDEO The S-VIDEO output separates the colour (C) and luminance (Y) signals before transmitting them to the TV set in order to achieve a sharper picture. So this must be selected from the menu to enable the S-VIDEO output to function.

Handling Disc

- To keep a disc clean condition, please do not touch a side containing play information.
- Do not attach a bit of paper or sticky tape on it.
- Do not expose a disc to a direct sunlight or electric heating systems.
- After using it, please keep a disc in a case.



Cleaning Disc

- Before using it, please rub it from centre toward outside with a clean cloth.
- Do not use any type of solvent such as thinner, benzol (benzene), commercial cleaning goods or antistatic sprays.



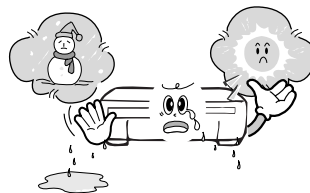
Basic information about VCR and Videotape

What is dew condensation symptom?

- If a player is moved from a cool place to a warm and damp place or a place facing a direct cool wind from air-conditioner...and others, temperature varies sharply, which makes dew on head drums of player.

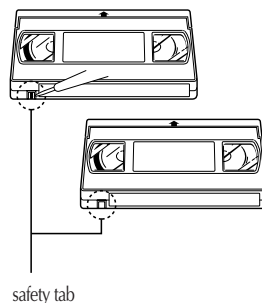
If dew condensation occurs,

- 1 First, turn it on for one or two hours before using it.
- 2 Do not use it because it may develop troubles of a player or videotape.



What is a record tab of a videotape?

- The tab on a videotape enables a user to record and prevents the recorded area from rerecording.
- To record it, a user should use a videotape with a tab.
- If a user input a videotape without a tab to record, the videotape is ejected automatically.
- In order to avoid a recorded area to be rerecorded, a tab should be removed.
- To rerecord a recorded videotape, please scotch-tape on the removed tab position.



Noise

- Noise means poor screen conditions of player such as interruption or trembles in the top of bottom of a screen.
- If the picture is noisy, please adjust the "TRACKING" control buttons .
- Adjustment may not improve picture quality if the tape is originally recorded mixed with some noise or kept in poor conditions.
- If some noise remains after adjusting it, VCR heads may be contaminated or worn.
- In case VCR heads are contaminated, please insert a headCleaning tape (refer to its instructions!).



Auto-detect the contamination of VCR heads

- If the product, which has a auto-detector, detects a contaminated head(s), it shows the conditions to notice the contamination on screen.
* In case of the notice on screen, please rub the heads with a head-cleaner followed by "How to use a head-cleaner".

How to use a head cleaner

- In case of a old or contaminated videotape, screen may not be clean from the contamination of player heads.
Please remove contaminants using a head-cleaner like below order.
- 1 Insert a head-cleaner into player
 - 2 Press "PLAY" for 5 seconds, and then press "FF" for about 10 seconds.

- 3 Eject a head-cleaner from player
 - If the screen is not clean yet, please repeat the above 2 or 3 times more.
 - A head-cleaner is not for sale. Please ask it for the nearest agent.
 - In case a user ask the removal of contaminants of us, the user should pay extra charges.

Before doubting about troubles (VCR)

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■ Power

• "Power On" does not work.	➤ Please check whether a power plug is inserted in an electric outlet.
• It does not work even in "Power On".	➤ Please check whether a videotape is inserted in. ➤ Try to insert a plug again.

■ Input and ejection

• A videotape is not inputted in.	➤ Please check whether a power plug is inserted in an electric outlet. ➤ Please check whether a videotape is in. ➤ Please check whether a videotape is inserted in a right direction (a side of transparent window should be on the upside) ➤ Have you inputted a videotape again just after the tape was ejected? Please try it again after fully ejecting it. ➤ When a videotape forces to be ejected, the tape may not be inputted. In the case, please pull out an outlet, and then push the tape smoothly.
• On inputting a videotape, the tape is re-ejected.	➤ That's why a safe mode to protect a videotape is operated automatically. Please pull out the tape and input it again.
• A videotape is not ejected.	➤ In case the product is used for a long time, a videotape may not be ejected for a film inside may be stretched. In the case, please pull out a power plug for about 10mins and then press "EJECT" button.

■ Screen and noise

• A channel on video and a play screen does not appear.	➤ Please check your antenna's connection. ➤ TV channel should be fixed on video channel. ➤ Please check your antenna's signal whether it may be weak. In case of its weakness, please use a frequency amplifier connected with the device. ➤ Press "TV/VCR" and then let "VCR" is displayed on the display panel.
