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Important Notes

- 1. Before operating your LCD Monitor system, please read these instructions carefully.
- 2. Retain this manual for future reference.
- 3. Do not remove any WARNING stickers on the unit.
- 4. Do not use any chemical solvent, cleaning agent or corrosive detergent to clean away dirt on the surface of the screen. Doing so may cause irreversible damage to the surface of the LCD screen. To clean off dirt or fingerprints, it is recommended that a soft-damp lens-cleaning cloth be used.
- 5. Using spare parts from another manufacturer may cause permanent damage to the unit.
- Avoid installing the monitor screen in a position that is exposed to direct sunlight and hot air vents.
- 7. Install the unit in a dry location, avoid condensation.
- 8. Ensure that all wiring is properly connected before operating the unit.
- 9. Should the LCD panel break, avoid contact with the broken glass or fluid leaking out from the enclosure. If you come into contact, flush and clean the affected areas with plenty of water. Seek medical attention immediately.
- 10. When operating the monitor, avoid touching or pressing on the LCD screen. Excessive force will damage the LCD screen.
- 11. When installing this unit in a vehicle, ensure that the installation and use of this unit is in compliance with local vehicle rules and regulations.
- 12. Before replacing a blown fuse, turn the unit off and disconnect all power. Ensure the replacement fuse is of the same rating (5A) of the fuse being replaced.
- 13. If during operation the unit overheats or malfunctions, turn off the power and contact your dealer. Do NOT disassemble the unit, there are no user serviceable parts in the unit.
- 14. Ensure that no foreign objects are in the unit when the LCD screen is closed.
- 15. The battery (CR2025) in the remote control has a useful lifetime of approximately 6-months. To ensure proper and reliable operation, replace the battery in a timely manner.
- 16. When the unit is used in conjunction with a radio/TV tuner, reception quality will vary depending on the geographic location and weather conditions.
- 17. The rated operating temperature range of the unit is 32°–92° F. Cool or warm the vehicle to within this temperature range prior to unit operation.
- 18. The picture viewing quality of this LCD is dependent on the installed location. Adjust the brightness control and/or the angle of the screen to achieve the optimum visual quality.

Installation

PRELIMINARY PREPARATIONS

NOTE: The unit should be installed by a qualified service technician. This unit is designed to operate with a 12 VDC, negative ground battery system.

NOTE: Use only proper sized fasteners and cables during installation. Use of improper fasteners or cables can lead to mechanical failure of the unit or create a fire hazard.

1. Disconnect the ground wire from the battery terminal prior to connecting the unit to the electrical system.

NOTE: Some vehicle radios have an anti-theft code system that will disable the radio if the battery is disconnected. If this vehicle has such a radio, ensure you have the access code to restore the radio to normal operation.

- 2. Pick a location to install the monitor where it will not obstruct the rear view mirror or the air conditioning vents.
- 3. Do not install this unit at an angle exceeding 30 degrees.



NOTE: The unit will automatically power off once the ACC is turned off (ignition key off). Ensure that the RED (+ACC) wire is connected to ACC power.

OHV Monitor Controls and Description




- 1. LCD display
- 2. ON/OFF/MODE button (**也**)
- 3. UP/DOWN buttons (▲/▼)
- 4. MENU button (🛄)
- 5. Door light On/Off button ()
- 6. Courtesy Light (➤<)
- 7. IR transmitter (headphones)
- 3. Open button
- 9. Remote sensor

Remote Control

NOTE: Ensure that the battery plastic protector has been removed from the remote control battery holder prior to use.


The frequently used buttons are described below.



- CH/DISC/SET (▲/▼)—use these buttons to adjust the selected setting on the MENU screen.
- 2. MODE—press this button to select the video source (AV1/AV2).
- 3. MENU—press this button to display the MENU screen. Continue to press this button additional times to scroll through the MENU selections.
- 4. POWER—press this button to turn power on or off to the unit.

Battery Replacement

- 1. Follow the instructions given in the illustration below to open the battery holder.
- 2. Remove the old battery and replace it with a CR2025 or equivalent. The positive (+) side of the battery must be facing upward in the clip.
- 3. Push the battery holder into the body of the remote control until the battery holder is locked.
- 4. Properly dispose of the old battery.



Operation

NOTE: Some functions are operational only when the LCD monitor is connected as an integrated system to other audio/visual peripherals; such as, radio tuner, TV tuner, VCD/DVD/CD player.

OPEN—LCD SCREEN

To open the LCD screen press the OPEN/CLOSE button and carefully rotate the LCD screen down to its operating position.

CLOSE—LCD SCREEN

To close the LCD screen rotate the LCD screen up to its stored position until you hear the OPEN/CLOSE button click.

SIGNAL SOURCE SELECTION

Select the input signal for viewing (AV1 or AV2) by momentarily pressing the MODE button (**4**) on the LCD screen or the MODE button on the remote.

ON/OFF CONTROL

Press and hold the (**b**) button on the LCD screen or momentarily press the POWER button on the remote.

FUNCTION MODE (MENU)

Press the MENU button on either the LCD screen or the remote to display the following setup options:

COLOR CONTRAST BRIGHTNESS TINT

RESET (restore factory default settings)

Use the MENU button on the LCD screen or use the MENU button (or the \wedge/\vee buttons) on the remote to scroll through the menu options. Once the desired setting is selected use the UP/DOWN buttons on the LCD screen or the >/< buttons on the remote to change the setting. After 5-seconds of inactivity the MENU screen will turn off.

DOOR LIGHT ON/OFF

Press this switch on the LCD screen to have the door open sensor operate the dome lights.

NOTE: This feature is operational only if the Gray or Purple door lock trigger wires have been connected to the door sensor.

The dome light selector switch contains two separate circuits. One for a positive dome light trigger and one for a negative dome light trigger. Please refer to the wiring table below for each of these triggers.

NEGATIVE DOME LIGHT TRIGGER

WIRE COLOR	CONNECTION
Gray	Battery ground
Blue	Battery +12VDC
Orange	Battery +12VDC
Purple	Negative door trigger


