

Introduction



Open/Close

Press to open or close the CD Drawer in *CD Mode*.

Program

Press to program a CD to play tracks in a designated order. In *Radio Mode*, press to save up to 10 AM and 10 FM radio stations into memory.

Volume

Press to adjust the volume.

Play/Pause/ Memory

In *CD Mode*, Press to play or pause a loaded CD. In *Radio Mode*, press to cycle through saved AM or FM radio stations.

Display

Press to switch between the clock and radio station in *Radio Mode*

Stop


Press to stop a CD during play.

Mode

Press to repeat a single track, repeat all tracks or randomize your track selection.

Skip/Tune

In timer setting mode, press to adjust the timer in increments/ decrements of 1. Press to skip. Press and hold to search in *CD Mode*. Press to tune an AM or FM station in *Radio Mode*.



Source

Press to switch between CD Mode, Radio Mode, and Aux Mode.

Press to turn the under cabinet music system off or on.

Turns the alarm on

Press to begin setting the alarm.

Press in power off mode to begin to set the clock.

Press to repeat a single track, repeat all tracks or randomize your track selection.

Press to cycle through saved AM or FM radio stations.


Press to play or pause a loaded CD.

Press to stop a CD during play.

Setup


Power

Plug the attached AC cord into a standard AC power outlet to power the unit.



Remote

Requires 1 CR2025 battery (pre-installed)



Battery Backup

Requires 2 AAA batteries (not included)

The battery backup is designed for shortterm unexpected power outages. Under these circumstances, the time and alarm settings will be saved. The music system cannot power primary functions such as the radio.

Mounting

A mounting template , which contains mounting instructions, is included in the packaging.

IMPORTANT: You should only use the mounting accessories included with this under cabinet music system when attempting to mount it under a cabinet. Use of unapproved accessories that have not been designed specifically for this unit could lead to safety hazards. **WARNING:** The remote control's button cell battery contains mercury. Do not put in the trash, instead recycle or dispose of as hazardous waste.

Clock

Setting the Clock

1. In power off, press and hold the **Clock** button.

The hour on the display will begin blinking.

- 2. Press the **Skip/Tune** buttons to adjust the hour.
- 3. Press the **Clock** button.

The minutes on the display will begin blinking.

- 4. Press the **Skip/Tune** buttons to adjust the minutes.
- 5. Press the **Clock** button to finish setting the time.

Setting the Timer

1. Press the **Timer** button repeatedly to adjust the timer in increments of 10 min

Ex. 180,170 or OFF.

- Press the Skip/Tune buttons to adjust the timer in increments/ decrements of 1 min.
- After the set time has expired, the under cabinet music system will sound an alarm.
- 4. To cancel the alarm after it has sounded, press the **Power** button.
- To cancel the timer before the alarm has sounded, press the **Timer** button repeatedly until it is set to OFF

Setting the Alarm

1. In power off, press and hold the **Alarm Set** button.

The hour on the display will begin blinking.

- 2. Press the **Skip/Tune** buttons to adjust the hour.
- 3. Press the Alarm Set button.

The minutes on the display will begin blinking.

- 4. Press the **Skip/Tune** buttons to adjust the minutes.
- 5. Press the Alarm Set button.
- 6. Press the **Skip/Tune** button to select the alarm source.

CD, AM, FM or Buzzer.

- 7. Press the Alarm Set button.
- 8. To turn the alarm off, press the **Alarm On/Off** button.
- 9. To cancel the alarm before the alarm has sounded, press the **Alarm On/Off** button.

CD and Radio

Loading a CD

- 1. Press the **Power** button to turn the under cabinet music system on.
- 2. Press the source button to switch to *CD Mode*.
- 3. Press the **Open/Close** button to open the CD drawer.
- 4. Load a CD into the CD drawer, label side facing up.
- 5. Once the CD is loaded, the CD should start playing automatically.
- If the CD does not start playing automatically, press the **Play/Pause** button.

Programming a CD

- 1. Follow the instructions for Loading A CD.
- 2. Press the **Stop** button.
- 3. Press the **Prog** button.

"01", indicating the current program track, will begin flashing on the display.

- 4. Press the **Skip/Tune** buttons to select the CD track you would like to play in the program.
- 5. Press the **Prog** button.
- 6. Repeat steps 3, 4, and 5 to continue programming CD tracks.

Up to 20 tracks can be programmed.

- Press the **Play/Pause** button to begin playing the programmed CD.
- 8. To cancel a program, press the **Stop** button twice.

Tuning the Radio

- 1. Press the **Power** button to turn the under cabinet music system on.
- 2. Press the **Source** button to switch to AM or FM *Radio Mode*.

Radio Mode is indicated by "AM" or "FM" on the display.

- 3. Press the **Skip/Tune** button to tune the AM or FM radio.
- 4. Hold down the **Skip/Tune** button to scan for the next available station.

Saving a Station as a Preset

- 1. Follow the instructions for <u>Tuning the Radio</u>.
- 2. Tune to the desired station.
- 3. Press the **Prog** button.
- 4. Preset number will appear on the display.
- 5. Press the **Skip/Tune** buttons to adjust to the desired preset number.
- Press the **Prog** button to save the current radio station to the selected preset.

Tuning Preset Radio Stations

- 1. Follow the instructions for <u>Tuning the</u> <u>Radio</u> and <u>Saving a Station as a Preset</u>.
- 2. Press the **Memory** button to cycle through preset radio stations

Connecting an MP3 Device

Connecting an MP3 Device


- Slide the release button located on the bottom of the unit and the Cradle will extend downward.
- 2. Place an MP3 Device into the **Cradle**.
- 3. Connect the **Line Input Cable** to the headphone jack on an MP3 Device.
- 4. Press the **Source** button to switch to *AUX Mode*.

Playing Audio from the MP3 Device

- 1. Follow the instructions for <u>Connecting An MP3 Device</u>
- 2. Press the **Power** button to turn the under cabinet music system on.
- 3. Press the **Source** button to switch to *AUX Mode*.

AUX Mode is indicated by "AUX" on the display.

4. Use the native controls on the connected MP3 Device to play music.
