Introduction

REPEAT Press repeatedly to set the current track or entire album to repeat.

POWER Press to turn the karaoke machine off or on.

ECHO

Turn to adjust the echo.

MIC 1 VOLUME

Turn to adjust the volume from the MIC 1 INPUT.

BALANCE

Turn to adjust the balance.


MIC 1 INPUT

PROGRAM

Press to program a loaded disc to play tracks in a specified order.

STOP

Press to stop a disc during play.



SOURCE

Use to adjust the source.

AVC

Turn to adjust the automatic voice control (See page 9 for detailed information on AVC).

MIC 2 VOLUME

Turn to adjust the volume from the MIC 2 INPUT.

MASTER VOLUME

Turn to adjust the volume.

MIC 2 INPUT

STEREO HEADPHONE JACK


SKIP/SEARCH

Press to skip between tracks on a loaded disc. Press and hold to fastforward or fast-rewind the current track on a loaded CD (*this feature does not work with CD*+*G*).

PLAY/PAUSE

Press to play or pause a loaded disc.

LED DISPLAY



Setup

Power

Plug the included AC/DC power adapter into the **DC POWER INPUT** and an AC power outlet to power the karaoke machine.



CD and CD+G Discs

Automatic Voice Control

The **AVC** (Automatic Voice Control) dial adjusts the volume of the unit to compensate for varying levels of volume from the microphone. Turn the dial to adjust the degree to which the Automatic Voice Control compensates for variations in volume.

Loading a Disc

- 1. Press the **OPEN/CLOSE** button on the CD door.
- Load a CD, CD-R/RW, or CD+G disc into the karaoke machine, label side facing up.
- 3. Close the CD door.

Playing a Loaded Disc

- 1. Follow the instructions for <u>Loading</u> <u>a Disc</u>.
- 2. Adjust the **SOURCE** switch to CD+G or CD mode.
- Press the PLAY/PAUSE button to begin playing the loaded disc.

Programming a Loaded Disc

- 1. Follow the instructions for <u>Loading</u> <u>a Disc</u> and <u>Playing a Loaded Disc</u>.
- 2. Press the **STOP** button to stop the loaded disc.
- 3. Press the **PROGRAM** button.
- Press the SKIP/SEARCH buttons to select a track from the loaded disc.
- 5. Press the **PROGRAM** button to add the selected track to the program.
- 6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 to program up to 20 tracks to play in a specified order.
- Press the **STOP** button to cancel a program.

Video Input and Output

Composite Video Input

Requires an RCA video cable (included)

- 1. Connect an RCA video cable to the **COMPOSITE VIDEO INPUT** on the karaoke machine and a video output on an external video source.
- 2. Adjust the **SOURCE** switch to AUX mode.
- 3. Use the native controls on the external video source to play and control video.

Composite Video Output

Requires an RCA video cable (included)

- Connect an RCA video cable to the **RCA VIDEO OUTPUT** on the karaoke machine and a video input on a television.
- 2. Adjust the television source to the input used in step one.
- CD+G lyrics played through the karaoke machine will now be seen on the connected television.

Audio Input and Output

RCA Audio Input

Requires an RCA audio cable (included)

- Connect an RCA audio cable to the RCA AUDIO INPUT on the karaoke machine and an audio output on an external audio source.
- Adjust the SOURCE switch to AUX mode.
- Use the native controls on the external audio source to play and control audio.

RCA Audio Output

Requires an RCA audio cable (included)

- Connect an RCA audio cable to the RCA AUDIO OUTPUT on the karaoke machine and an audio input on an external stereo system.
- 2. Adjust the external stereo systems source to the input used in step one.
- Audio played through the karaoke machine will now be heard through the connected stereo system.
