
# **Before Use**

# **!** CAUTION

Please keep small parts such as the plastic tabs out of children's reach. Throw the plastic tab away.

**Note:** A plastic tab was attached to the toy for in-store demonstration purposes. While the tab may have already been removed, check the bottom of the toy to be sure. If the plastic tab is still attached, pull and remove the tab from the toy. Throw the plastic tab away.

# **Battery Replacement**



For best results, we recommend replacing the batteries that came with this toy with three, new "AA" (LR6) alkaline batteries.

- Locate the battery compartment on the bottom of the toy.
- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. Remove the battery compartment door. Throw the exhausted batteries away.
- Insert three, new "AA" (LR6) **alkaline** batteries, as indicated inside the battery compartment.

**Hint:** We recommend using **alkaline** batteries for longer battery life.

- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screws with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.
- When sounds or lights from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries!


#### **Battery Safety Information**

Batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your toy. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated on the battery compartment door.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the toy. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in a fire. The batteries may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging.
- If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.

- Tap the bongo to hear the beats and three festive songs as it lights up!
- Tap the tambourine to hear a short riff and to change the bongo style from calypso, to reggae, to island style.



#### Care

- Wipe the toy with a clean cloth dampened with a mild soap and water solution.
- Do not immerse the toy.
