Battery Replacement

For best performance, we recommend replacing the batteries that came with this toy with three, new alkaline "AAA" (LR03) batteries.

- Locate the battery compartment door on underside of each toy.
- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. Remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert three, "AAA" (LR03) alkaline batteries.

Hint: We recommend using **alkaline** batteries for longer battery life.

- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw with a Phillips screwdriver.
 Do not over-tighten.
- When sounds from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries!

Battery Safety Information


Batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your toy. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the toy. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in a fire. The batteries may explode or leak.
- Never short circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging.
- If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Hear the Roar!







- Locate the power switch on the underside of each toy.
- Slide the power switch to the position to turn the toy on, and to the position to turn it off.
- Squeeze the lever on the underside of each toy to hear a roar!

Care

Wipe the toy with a clean cloth dampened with a mild soap and water solution. Do not immerse the toy.
