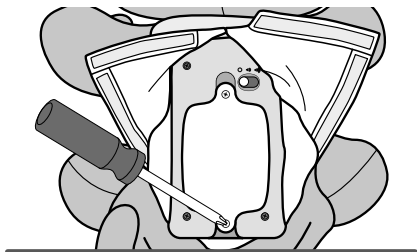

Battery Replacement



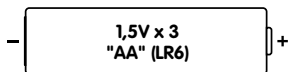
For best performance, we recommend replacing the batteries that came with this toy with three, new "AA" (LR6) alkaline batteries.

- Open the fasteners on the back of the toy.
- Loosen the screws in the sound box battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. Remove the door. Remove the exhausted batteries and dispose of them properly.
- Insert three, new "AA" (LR6) **alkaline** batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screws. Do not over-tighten.
- Close the fasteners on the back of the toy.
- If this toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power/volume switch off and back on.
- When sounds from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.



- Protect the environment by not disposing of this product with household waste (2002/96/EC). Check your local authority for recycling advice and facilities.

Battery Safety Information





In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.

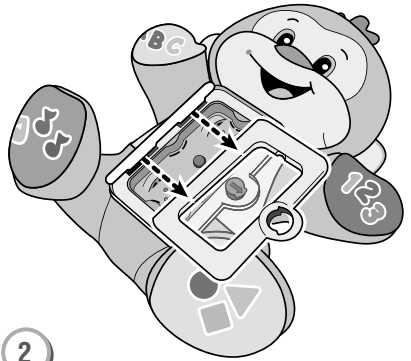

- Turn your device power ON and open the Fisher-Price® Monkey app.

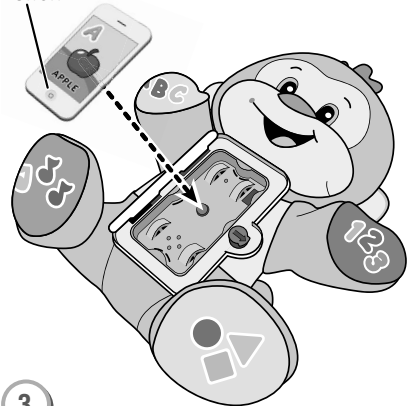

- Lift the door slightly and then slide to remove it from the device compartment.

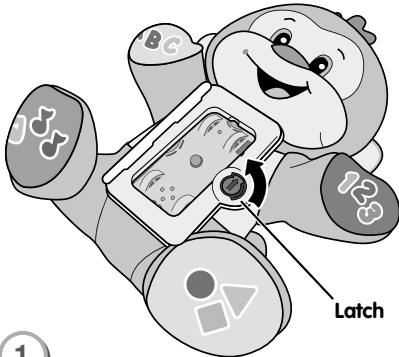
*Hint: If you'd like to **block** your child from pressing the home button, follow the instructions in this step.*

- Insert the device with the home button towards the monkey's feet.

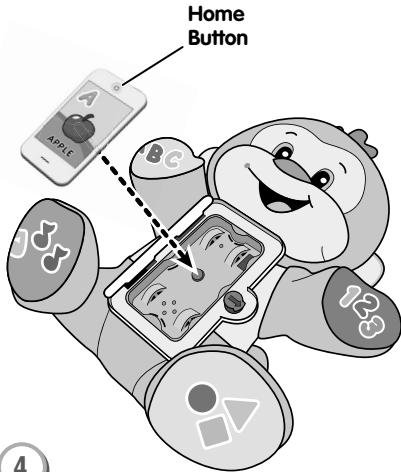

- Turn the latch to unlock the door.

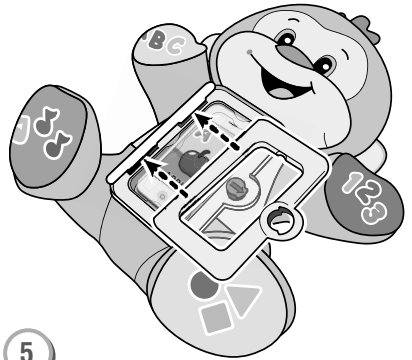
Insert Your Apple Device

Hint: If you'd like to **allow** your child to press the home button, follow the instructions in this step.



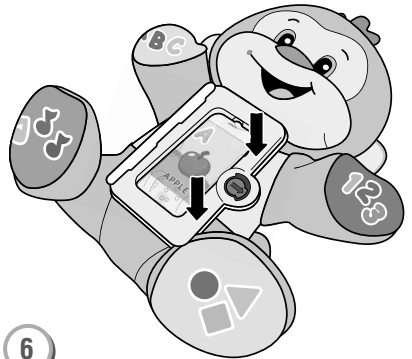
