
Adult assembly is required.





Battery Installation



- Locate the battery compartment on the back of the Townhouse.
- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver.
- · Lift to remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert three "D" (LR20) alkaline batteries.

Helpful Hint: We recommend using **alkaline** batteries for longer battery life.


- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screws with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.
- When sounds or lights from this toy stop working, stay on constantly, or work erratically, it's time for an adult to replace the batteries!

Battery Safety Information

Batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:


- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
 Always remove exhausted batteries from the product.
 Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in a fire. The batteries may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the product before charging.
- If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Attaching the Deck



- Position the Townhouse face up on a flat surface, so that the bottom faces you.
- Fit the deck tabs into the grooves in the bottom of the Townhouse, as shown.
- Insert two screws through the holes in the bottom of the deck and into the bottom of the Townhouse.
- Tighten the screws with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.


Let's Decorate!



Helpful Hint: Apply the labels as shown in the illustrations. For best results, wash your hands before applying the labels and make sure the areas to which the labels will be applied are clean and dry.

- Apply the top corners of a label first and smooth downward to remove any air bubbles.
- For best results, avoid repositioning a label once it has been applied.


Inserting the Window Films



Helpful Hint: The window films "illuminate" when light is behind the Townhouse. For best results, place the Townhouse in front of a window or other light source.

- Locate the film slots on the back of the Townhouse.
- Insert and slide the "cloud" film into the bedroom film slots.
- Insert and slide the "trees" film into the terrace film slots.
- Insert and slide the "garden" film into the kitchen film slots.


Adding the Flowers



Helpful Hint: The flowers can be attached and re-attached to any window box.

- Locate the window boxes on the outside of the Townhouse. Here
- Fit the tab on a flower onto the edge of a window box.


Attaching the Curtains and Valances



Helpful Hint: Use the longer curtain rods for double windows and the shorter curtain rod for the single window.

Slide a curtain or valance on to a curtain rod, as shown.

curtain or valance rod into


each set of clips as shown.

· Rotate the Townhouse walls out to open.


Ding Dong




• Press the door bell to hear it ring and turn on the front door light and inside foyer light.

Fun Lights and Sounds!

Hint: All lights will turn off automatically after up to three minutes.




- · Press the phone to hear it ring.
- Press the light switch to turn on the overhead light.
- · Open the refrigerator to turn on its interior light.
- Press the stove button to turn on the stove burners and the oven light.




Press the mantle button to light the fire and the candle.

Lights and Sounds, Please!




- Open the terrace doors to hear birds chirping.
- Press the light switch to turn on the light.




Open the roll-top desk and the computer screen glows!

Playtime's Over

- Place the family and their accessories inside the Townhouse.
- Rotate the front side of the Townhouse toward the backside until they almost meet.



• Lift the back (wider) side slightly and close it over the tab on the front (narrower) side.



 After the Townhouse is latched closed, the product can be carried by an adult. Grasp the Townhouse in the upper left windows as shown.
