
This player is an MP3 player with removable storage hard disk and fashionable appearance. It is user-friendly, easy to operate and provides recoding, music playing and repeating function.



### **Operational Notes**

- " If the MP3 player will not be operated for a prolonged period, remove the battery to avoid possible damage caused by electricalleakage.
- " The MP3 player should be kept in areas freefrom extreme temperature changes, moisture and dust.
- " Set the HOLD switch to release position before operation
- Do not dropthe player
- " Battery life may vary depending on usage condition and manufacture date.
- " Please change the battery under Low Battery indicator displayed.(All buttons are not responding even after the battery has been taken out and replaced)
- " Do not use the player for a very long periodin order to protect your audioability
- " If the playerstopsrunning under properoperation, please reset by taking out battery.
- " Do not use player when driving or cycling.
  - The optimum temperature for operation is 5 -45 degree Celsius(41F-95F) with humidity between 10% and 75 %.

## **Operating Instructions**

### Load battery

Open the battery compartment and load one AAA7 battery as directed by "+" and "-".



### Change battery

When the LCD displays "Low Battery", it indicates a need of battery change. Turn off the machine before replacing a new battery.



### Turning the power on/off

The OSD with blue backlightappears when PLAY/STOPbutton is pressed. The lengthof time for the backlightto stay on is depending onuser setting. Switching the power of by pressing on the PLAY/STOP button continuously. When the machine has idledfor a while, auto power off will activate according to the time set by user. You can set "Disable" function to let machine cancel this function.





### **Functional Options**

Music playing, voice playing& recording, radio function

Press "Menu" to select music mode. Thenpress "Menu" again to confirm playing music (machine will automatically switch back to music model no operation for morethan 10 seconds). You can play Mp3 and WMA format files inthis mode. LCD displays "music" as:

Music play mode

Press "Menu" button into music mode. Press "+" button to select voice mode and press "Menu" button again to confirm this mode. It is the same procedure transferring from "voice mode" to music mode. LCD displays voice as:

Voice play mode



Press "Menu" button into music mode. Press "+" button two times to selectFM Tuner mode. Press "Menu" again to confirm FM Tuner mode. Press "Menu" button into music mode.





Press "+", "-" button to select music, voice, radio, settings, erase files about or exit mode. Press "Menu" again to confirm selection. (Ref. P. 15)


Under play or pausemode, press down Play/Stop▶\■button for 3 seconds to jump to stopmode, and press Play/Stopbutton again to returnto

Note: Only in stop mode, hold play/stop button to switch off themachine. If the machine is playing, please stopplaying first before switching off. LCD displays stop mode when music is stopped playing




Press FF ▶▶ button to select next song. Press RW I◀ button to selectorevious song.



#### VOL+/ VOL-

By pressing VOL+/VOL- button, you could control the volume under either Play or Pause mode. The volume steps (see illustration) will increase or decrease when then the VOL+/VOL- button is pressed correspondingly.



### Repeat A-B function


Under music/voice mode, you canpress A-B/EQ button toselect A andB, then A-B musicor voice will play continuously. PressA-B/EQ button to cancel, LCDdisplays as:



Remark: Under stop mode, this function out of operation. PressA-B/EQ/REC for a period of timeto change into EQ setting. (For EQsetting please refer to P. 13)

#### EQ setting

Under the playing mode, press A-B/EQ buttonfor a period of time to select 6 different music modes:



### Music/Voice information display:

When in play/stop status, the display will scrollto show the information of music or voicefile, e.g. song title, distributor, copyright, etc. The nextline shows the songor voice file number e.g. song001 or voice001. Next it is the current playing time of the musicor voice file, and then the total playing time.





### Advanced function

Followed are the moreadvanced functions of our MP3 player for you. You can press "Menu" button to select 6 modes



### MENU

Press "Menu" button to enter thismode. Press "+" . "-" to cycle selecting above6 functions and press "Menu" button again to confirmyour selecting.

Note: No operation in 5seconds, machine returns to latestsetting mode.

### Music mode (Ref. P. 10)

This is the defaultmode. Users can playMP3/WMA files underthis mode. Users can also run repeat (Ref.P. 22) /A-B/RW/FF/V+,-/EQ setting in this mode.

### Voice mode

### **Start Recording**

Under Voice Function, press "A-B/EQ" button to start recording (build-in Microphone, microphone's position can be seen in P.2). The display is as follows:

### Stop Recording

Press "A-B/EQ" button again to stoprecording.

### **Play Recording**

The operating procedure is the same as operating music files (Ref. page 11). (Display reference in Page 13)

Note: "A-B" repeat function only works in playing or pause mode. Users cannot use this function in recording or stop mode.


Press "A-B/EQ" for awhile and then userscan adjust the "EQ" mode in play/stop/pause status. Users cannot usethis function in recordingmode.

### **FM Tuner**

#### ■ FM tuner mode



Press 'menu' button to auto search and memorizeup to 32 radiochannels.

#### FM fine tuner

Press ► I or I < 1 to finetune. By pressing "A-B/EQ" button for a moment, the machine will memorize the current radiofrequency. If youwant to repeat theauto search function, pressstop/play button until "P' appearedon the screen, then press ► ► I and I < 1 to activate theauto search function again. Similarly, if you want to finetune any channels, you only need to press play/stopbutton once till the 'p' disappeared from the screen. You may now finetune the channel by press the "A-B/EQ" button for a while



### FM Recording

Press " A-B/EQ " button to start recording the current listening radio channel. The display is shown below:

Press the same buttonagain to stop recording. You canplay the recorded file in voicemode. The display isshown below:

### Playing recorded FMfiles

Press 'Menu' button toreturn to voice playingmode. Press ▶ I and I 
to search for therecorded files and pressplay button to playthe file. You 
can treat the fileas common music fileto run EQ setupand other related 
functions

### Operation of FM files in PC

When the USB connectionbetween the mp3 playerand PC has completed, you can find thatthere is a folder called 'FM'in the player. Inside you can find the recorded FM files. Just like other musicfiles, you can rename, copyor delete the Recorded FM files.



### Quit FM Tuner mode

Press 'Menu' button toquit FM tuner modeand back to musicor voice mode.

### Line-in recording function

**1.Connection** Use the CD line-incable to connect the player with CD player (or other audio equipment) as shown below:



### 2.Recording

Press " Menu " and then press " +, - " to select " Line IN " . Press " Menu " to confirm ands tart recording.

As the meantime, press the playbutton on the CDplayer and start the recording as shownbelow:



### 3.Playing recorded files


Press " Menu" button to return tomain menu and selectmusic playing mode. Press ▶ and I◄ to find the wave file 001.WAV.Press play to listento the recorded musicifiles from CD. You can configure and adjust the EQ mode of the file justlike the normal musicifiles.





### 4. Operation on recorded music files

Connect the player with PC by a USBcable. Youmay find a foldercalled "LINE In" in the flash memory of mp3player.Inside you can findthe file you haverecorded. Like common musicfiles, you may also play/rename/copy/deletethe file.





### Connection with computer

Connect the USB cable with the computer USB port.

#### Installation of Driver

After connecting with computer, Windows 2000/ME/XP willautomatically identify and install the driver. The machine is ready touse when a "removable drive" icon appears in "my computer". The attached CD-ROM is needed for Windows-985 to install Driver.



#### Windows 98SE CD-ROM installation


Put the attached CD-ROM intocomputer, and then install the software according toinstruction.

Note: Do not unplug themachine with computer when thefile is reading, writing ordeleting. Foxda Technology is not liablefor any damage/lose of anyfiles.


### Formatting
