## **Operational Notes**

- " If the MP3 player will not be operated for a prolonged period, remove the battery to avoid possible damage caused by electrical leakage.
- " The MP3 player should be kept in areas free from extreme temperature changes, moisture and dust.
- " Set the HOLD switch to release position before operation
- " Do not drop the player
- " Battery life may vary depending on usage condition and manufacture date.
- " Please change the battery under Low Battery indicator displayed.(All buttons are not responding even after the battery has been taken out and replaced)
- " Do not use the player for a very long periodin order to protect your audioability
- " If the playerstopsrunning under properoperation, please reset by taking out battery.
- " Do not use layer when driving or cycling.
- " The optimum temperature for operation is 5 -45 degree Celsius(41F -95F) with humidity between 10% and 75 %.

When the LCD displays"Low Battery "it indicates a need of batterychange. Turn offthe machine before replacing a newbattery.

#### Turning the power on/off

The "HELLO" greeting appearswhen "()" "button is pressed. The length of timefor the backlight to stay on is depending on userpreference. Switching the power offby pressing on the" ▶\■ "button continuously." BYEBYE " will appear on the screenbefore the machine hasswitched off.

# **Functional Options**

#### Music playing, voice playing& recording, radio function

Press "Function" to entermusic mode (default setting). You canplay Mp3 and WMAformat files in this mode.



Press "Function" button again to enter voice mode.



Press "Function" button again to enterFM Tuner mode.



# Music playing functions

The default OSD isin stop status undermusic mode

#### Play/Pause/Stop/FF/RW

Press Play/Stopbutton to play, LCD displays as:

Press Play/Stop button againto pause playing, LCDdisplays as:

Under pause mode, pressdown Play/Stop button for3 seconds to jumpto stop mode, and press Play/Stop button again to return to playing music mode. LCD displaysas:

Press FF I button to select next song. PressRW button to selectorevious song. Note: Only in stopmode, hold play/stop button to switch off themachine. If the machine is playing, pleasestop playing first beforeswitching off.

#### VOL+/ VOL-

By pressing VOL+/VOL- button, you could control the volume under either Playor Pause mode. The volume steps(see illustration) will increase or decrease when then the VOL+ /VOL- button is pressed-correspondingly.

#### Repeat A-B function

Under music/voice mode, youcan press A-B/EQbutton to selectA and B, then A-B musicor voice will play continuously. Press A-B/EQbutton to cancel, LCDdisplays as:



Remark: Under stop mode, thisfunction is out of operation.Press A-B/EQ/REC for a period of timeto change into EQ setting.

#### EQ setting

Under the playing mode, press A-B/EQ buttonfor a period of time to select 6 different music modes: Normal, DBB, Jazz, Rock, Classical, and Pop. LCD displays as:



Music playing mode:

Press "FUNCTION" for a while to enable the repeat playing function.



### Interpreting the message regardingmusic file and voicefile

When in play/stop status, the display will show the number of musicor voice file, e.g. 003. After the file number is the current playing time of the music orvoice file. The total time for the music and voice file is shown at the beginning when the file starts playing (for 1 second)



#### Erasing a music file

Under "STOP" mode, press "FUNCTION" and "+" at the same time, then you will see the following appeared on the screen:



Press ">> I ++ " to choose Yes or No. Press Stop/play to confirm, or press other key to cancel.

When the file has beenerased, the display will showas follows:



# Voice mode

Under music mode, press "FUNCTION" button to enter voicemode. Under voice mode, you can select play/record/repeat/A-B/RW/FF/V+,-/EQ setting.

# Start Recording

Under Voice Function, press "A-B/EQ" button and you willsee that "REC MIC" has appeared on the screen. Press "A-B/EQ" again to start recording. Display is the same s follows:



At the mean time, if you press ▶ and **H** and **H** and **T** and **H** and

#### Stop Recording

Press "A-B/EQ" button again to stop recording. Display is shown below



#### Play / Recording

The operating procedure is the same as playing normal music files

Remarks: "A-B" repeating function can only function in play/stop status. "EQ" mode can only be changed by pressing the "A-B/EQ" button under play/stop/pause status. It cannot function in recording mode.

Erase voice files

Under "STOP"status of voicemode, press "FUNCTION" and "+" at the same time, then you will see the following appeared on the screen:

# FM tuner function

### Enter FM tuner mode

Press "Function" button to enterFM tuner mode. (Adjust the direction of earphone line to get betterradio effect)

#### Auto search

Press "Function" button for a whileto auto search and memorize radio channels. When the LCD displays "SFARCH" (fig. 1), you can not cancelits operation until the auto search has finished. When the searching process has finished, the screen will show the first channel and how its frequency (fig. 2). RVHC can memorize radio channels as many as32 channels.



#### FM fine tuner

Press P or left to fine tune. By pressing "A-B/EQ" button for a moment, the machine will memorize the current radio frequency. If you want to repeat the auto search function, press stop/play button until appeared on the screen, then press **>>** or **ind** to activate the auto search function again. Similarly, if you want to fine tuneany channels, you onlyneed to press play/stopbutton once till the >> disappeared from the screen. You may now finetune the channel bypress the "A-B/EQ" button for a while.



When "P" appears on the screen, you can select the memorized channel: Stereo may appear according to the strength of signal. IFM Recording

#### FM record

Press "A-B/EQ" button to start recording the current listening radiochannel. The display is shownbelow:

Press the same button again to stop recording. You canplay the recorded file

in voice mode. The display is shown below:





#### Playing recorded FM files

Press "FUNCTION" button to return tovoice playing mode. Press →IandI∢-to search for the recorded orLine in files and press playbutton to play thefile. Youcan treat the fileas common music file torun EQ setup andother related functions

#### Operation of FM files in PC

When the USB connectionbetween the mp3 playerand PC has completed, you can find that there is a foldercalled "FM" in the player. Inside you can find the recorded FM files. Just like other musicfiles, you can rename, copy or delete the Recorded FM files.

#### Quit FM Tunermode

Press "FUNCTION" button to quit FMtuner mode and backto music or voicemode.

EQ Configuration: 6 differentEQ modes ( pleaserefer to p13 forconfiguration)

In order to lower the power consumption, this machine is designed to auto poweroff if it has been idled for 1 minute.

The default backlight ontime is 10 seconds. When you are operating the player, the backlight will turnon for 10 seconds.

#### Upload/download files

The operation for thisplayer is just likeother USB storage device, you can copy fileto related file folder, orto rename it forthe sake of betterunderstanding of song titleduring playing or recording.



After the machine hasconnected with a PC, choose the files thatyou want to copyand drag it to the removabledevice folder (mp3 player). The saved files willplay according to their file names. If youwant to change theirorder of playing, pleasechange their file names (Please refer to nextpage)

Remarks: During the processof uploading/downloading files, "WRITE/RD" will be shown on the screen. If you unplug the cableat this time, it may cause errors to the files.
