

- WARNING -

Pressure Relief Procedure

To reduce the risk of serious bodily injury, including fluid injection, splashing in the eyes or on the skin, or injury from moving parts, always follow this procedure whenever you shut off the pump, when checking or servicing any part of the spray/dispensing system, when installing, cleaning or changing spray tips/nozzles, and whenever you stop spraying/dispensing.

- Engage the spray gun/dispensing valve safety latch.
- 2. Shut off the air to the pump.
- Close the bleed-type master air valve (required in your system).
- Disengage the gun/valve safety latch.

- Hold a metal part of the gun/valve firmly to the side of a grounded metal pail, and trigger the gun/valve to relieve pressure.
- Engage the gun/valve safety latch.
- Open the drain valve (required in your system), having a container ready to catch the drainage.
- Leave the drain valve open until you are ready to spray/dispense again.

If you suspect that the spray tip/nozzle or hose is completely clogged, or that pressure has not been fully relieved after following the steps above, VERY SLOWLY loosen the tip guard retaining nut or hose end coupling and relieve pressure gradually, then loosen completely. Now clear the tip/nozzle or hose.

DISCONNECTING THE DISPLACEMENT PUMP

- Flush the pump if possible. Stop the pump at the bottom of its stroke. Follow the Pressure Relief Procedure Warning above.
- Disconnect the air and fluid hoses. Remove the pump from its mounting.
- See Fig 1. Screw the coupling nut (41) off of the air motor piston rod. Be careful not to lose the two couplers (40) as you lower the nut. Unscrew the tie rod locknuts (26) from the tie rods (31). Carefully pull the displacement pump (2) away from the air motor (1).

NOTE: Do not remove the connecting rod (42) from the displacement rod (C) unless the displacement rod is being replaced. If that is necessary, save the connecting rod for use with the new displacement rod.

To service the displacement pump, refer to Displacement Pump Model SP 217-527 at right. To service the air motor, refer to instruction manual 306-968 (supplied).

RECONNECTING THE DISPLACEMENT PUMP

- See Fig 1. If it was necessary to remove the connecting rod (42), apply a removable grade of Loctite® to its threads before assembling it to the displacement rod (C), and torque to 100-110 ft-lb (135-150 N.m).
- 2. Align the pump's fluid outlet (A) to the optional fluid outlet (B) of the air motor. Position the displacement pump (2) on the tie rods (31).
- Place the coupling nut (41) onto the connecting rod (42). Insert the couplers (40) into the coupling nut (41)

- from the top. Screw the coupling nut up onto the air motor shaft snugly. Screw the locknuts (26) onto the tie rods (31) loosely.
- Mount the pump and reconnect all hoses. Reconnect the ground wire if it was disconnected during repair.
- Tighten the tie rod locknuts (31) evenly, and torque to 40–50 ft-lb (54–68 N.m). Torque the coupling nut (41) to 145–155 ft-lb (195–210 N.m).
- 5. Start the pump and run it slowly, at about 40 psi (2.8 bar) air pressure, to check the tie rods for signs of binding. Adjust the tie rods as necessary to eliminate binding. Tighten the packing nut/wet-cup (D) with the wrench (28) supplied, so it is just snug no tighter. Fill the wet-cup half full with Graco Throat Seal Liquid or compatible solvent.


DISPLACEMENT PUMP MODEL SP 217-527

To repair Displacement Pump SP 217–527, refer to Instruction Manual 307–728 and follow all instructions given there, with the following exceptions:


- Packing Repair Kits 220-395 and 223-643 referenced in 307-728 do not include gland/packing stack 223-480, which is used in Model SP 217-527. The v-packings in this stack are one PTFE and four leather, as shown on page 5.
- The method of connecting Displacement Pump SP 217–527 to the air motor is different from that described in 307–728. Refer to the preceding paragraphs in this Supplement for instructions.




