How to view the online User Guide

To view the online multi-language iLM300 MicroPortable Projector User Guide on the CD, do the following:

1. Insert the User Guide CD into the CD-ROM drive.
2. The CD will start. Go to step 5. If the CD does not start, click Start, and then click Run.
3. Type `e:\launch.bat`, where e: is the CD-ROM drive.
4. Click OK. The CD browser page is displayed.
5. Follow the on-screen instructions.

Additional Help

The iLM300 User Guide includes comprehensive instructions on setting up and operating your projector. Here are some common setup issues and how to solve them.

1. Nothing appears on the screen.

Make sure you have attached the power cable, removed the lens cap, and pressed the power button on the top of the projector.

2. All I see is the start up screen.

Make sure the computer cable is connected between the computer and the projector. Try pressing the mobile computer activation keys more than once. Some machines require pressing the keys twice to activate the image.

Be certain you are using the right combination of activation keys for your computer. Appendix C in the online User Guide contains a list of key combinations for many mobile computers.

3. There is no computer image on the screen.

The projector might not synchronize with the computer signal. Press the Menu button on the projector keypad or remote control to open the menus. From the Basic menu, select Reset to synchronize the projector settings with the computer. See Chapter 2 in the online User Guide for more

information about adjusting the image settings with on-screen menus.

4. The image fills the screen, but the text is fuzzy and hard to read.

Set the mobile computer display resolution to the projector resolution of 1024x768. If your mobile computer resolution is only 800x600 or 640x480, the projector automatically converts the resolution to 1024x768.

Adjust the focus ring and the zoom ring to obtain a sharper image.

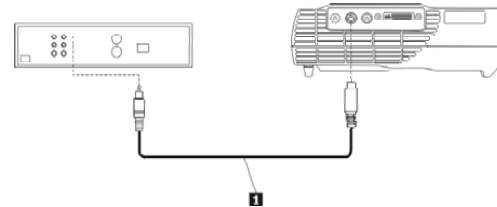
5. I can only see part of the computer image on the screen.

As in item 4. above, set the computer resolution to match the projector resolution. Use the activation keys to display the projected image.

Use the Keystone key on top of the projector to square the image.

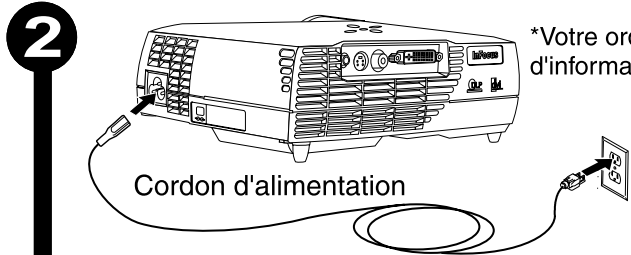
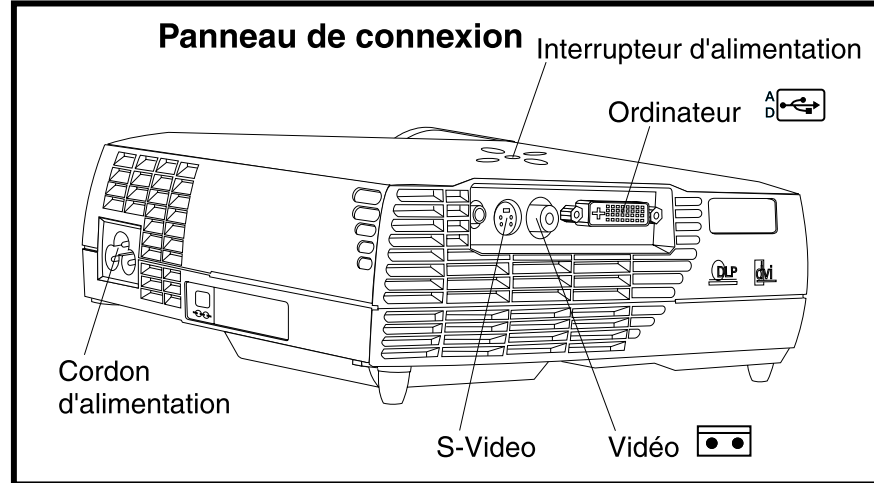
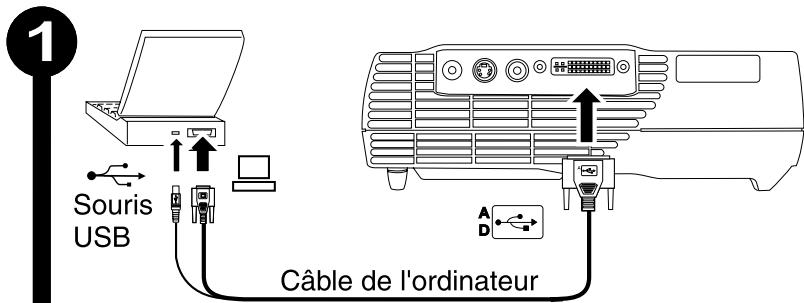
6. How do I attach digital video equipment to the projector?

Insert the video cable into the video connector in the player. Connect the opposite end to the projector S-Video connector.

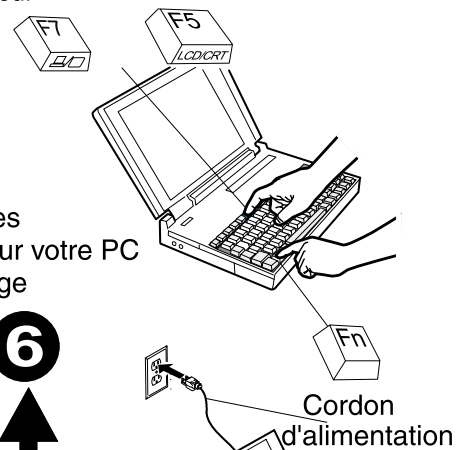
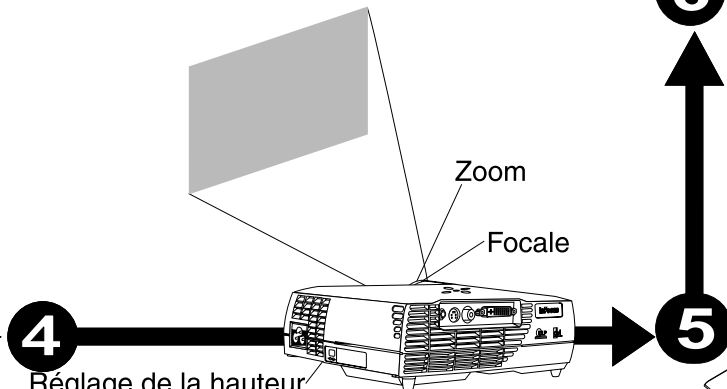
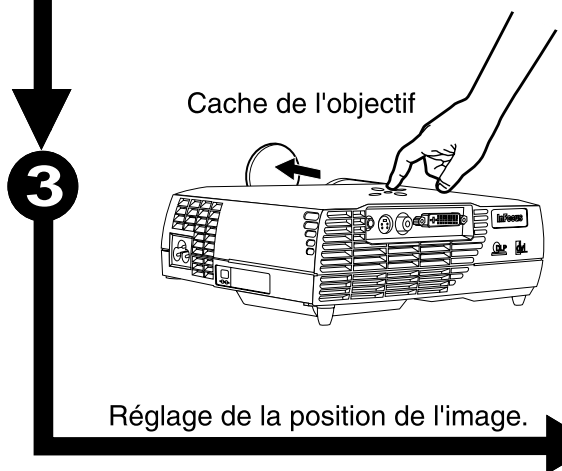

Comment visualiser le guide d'utilisation en ligne

Aide supplémentaire

Le guide d'utilisation iLM300 contient des instructions détaillées pour installer et utiliser le projecteur. Quelques unes des problématiques les plus courantes liées à la configuration, ainsi que leur mode de résolution, sont présentées ci-après.

1. Rien ne s'affiche à l'écran.

Assurez-vous d'avoir correctement branché le cordon d'alimentation, retiré le cache de l'objectif, et appuyé sur l'interrupteur d'alimentation situé en haut du projecteur.

2. Seul l'écran de démarrage est affiché.

Assurez-vous que le cordon reliant l'ordinateur au projecteur est bien branché. Essayez d'appuyer plusieurs fois sur les touches de déclenchement de votre ordinateur portable. Sur certaines machines, il est nécessaire d'appuyer deux fois sur ces touches pour activer l'image.

Assurez-vous que vous utilisez la bonne combinaison de touches de déclenchement pour votre ordinateur. L'Annexe C du guide d'utilisation en ligne contient une liste de combinaisons de touches pour de nombreux ordinateurs portables.

3. Aucune image en provenance de l'ordinateur ne s'affiche à l'écran.

Il se peut que le projecteur ne soit pas synchronisé avec le signal de l'ordinateur. Appuyez sur le bouton Menu du clavier ou de la télécommande pour ouvrir les menus. Depuis le menu Basic, sélectionnez

Reset pour synchroniser les paramètres du projecteur avec l'ordinateur. Pour plus d'informations sur l'ajustement des paramètres relatifs à l'image avec les menus à l'écran, reportez-vous au chapitre 2 du guide d'utilisation en ligne.

4. L'image remplit l'écran, mais le texte est flou et difficile à lire.

Définissez la résolution de l'écran du PC portable comme celle du projecteur (1024 x 768). Si la résolution de votre PC portable est seulement 800 x 600 ou 640 x 480, le projecteur la convertit automatiquement à 1024 x 768.

Réglez la bague de la variation de la focale et le zoom pour obtenir une image plus nette.

5. Une partie seulement de l'image de l'ordinateur est affichée à l'écran.

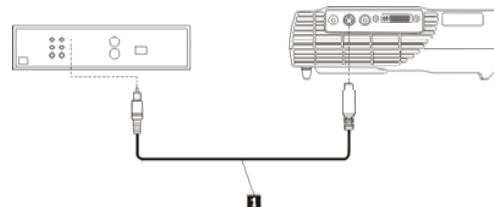

Aiuto aggiuntivo

La guida per l'utente iLM300 comprende istruzioni sull'installazione ed il funzionamento del proiettore. Di seguito sono riportate alcune istruzioni sull'installazione e sulla risoluzione dei problemi.

1. Sullo schermo non viene visualizzato niente.

Verificare che sia stato collegato il cavo di alimentazione, rimosso il cappuccio per le lenti e selezionato il pulsante di alimentazione, posto sulla parte superiore del proiettore.

2. Viene visualizzato il pannello di avvio.

Verificare che il cavo dell'elaboratore sia collegato all'elaboratore e al proiettore. Premere i tasti di attivazione dell'elaboratore portatile più di una volta. Alcune macchine richiedono la doppia selezione de tasti per attivare l'immagine.

Verificare che sia utilizzata la corretta combinazione di tasti di attivazione. L'appendice C nella guida per l'utente contiene un elenco di combinazioni dei tasti per molti computer portatili.

3. Non è visualizzata nessuna immagine del computer sullo schermo.

E' possibile che il proiettore non sia sincronizzato con il segnale dell'elaboratore. Per visualizzare i menu, premere il pulsante Menu sulla tastierina del proiettore o sul telecomando. Nel menu Di base, selezionare Reimposta per sincronizzare le impostazioni del proiettore con l'elaboratore. 4. L'immagine riempie lo schermo ma il testo è confuso e difficile da leggere.

Impostare la risoluzione video dell'elaboratore portatile ad una risoluzione del proiettore di 1024x768. Se la risoluzione dell'elaboratore portatile è solo 800x600 o 640x480, il proiettore converte la risoluzione a 1024x768 in modo automatico.

Regolare l'anello di messa in evidenza e l'anello dello zoom per visualizzare un'immagine più nitida.

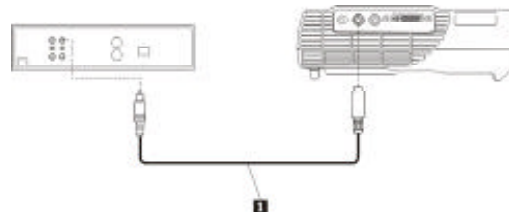

Cómo ver la Guía del usuario en línea

Ayuda adicional

1. No aparece nada en pantalla.

Asegúrese de haber enchufado el cable de alimentación, haber quitado la tapa del objetivo y haber pulsado el interruptor de encendido de la parte superior del proyector.

2. Todo lo que veo es la pantalla de inicio.

Asegúrese de que el cable del sistema está conectado del sistema al proyector. Intente pulsar las teclas de activación del sistema portátil una vez más. Algunas máquinas requieren que se pulsen las teclas dos veces para activar la imagen.

Asegúrese de que utiliza la combinación de teclas de activación correcta en su sistema. El apéndice C de la Guía de usuario en línea contiene una lista de las combinaciones de tecla para sistemas portátiles.

3. No aparece ninguna imagen del sistema en pantalla.

El proyector no puede sincronizar con el cable del sistema. Pulse el botón Menu en el área de teclado del proyector o en el mando a distancia para abrir los menús. 1. Der Bildschirm bleibt leer.

Stellen Sie sicher, dass das Netzkabel angeschlossen ist, die Kappe vom Objektiv entfernt und der Netzschalter oben auf dem Projektor gedrückt wurde.

2. Nur die Startanzeige wird angezeigt.

Stellen Sie sicher, dass der Computer und der Projektor über das Computerkabel miteinander verbunden sind. Drücken Sie die Aktivierungstasten des tragbaren Computers mehrmals. Bei einigen Maschinen müssen Sie die Tasten zweimal drücken, um das Bild zu aktivieren.

Achten Sie darauf, dass Sie die richtige Kombination von Aktivierungstasten für den Computer drücken. Anhang C im Online-Benutzerhandbuch enthält eine Liste der Tastenkombinationen für viele tragbare Computer.

3. Auf dem Bildschirm wird kein Computerbild angezeigt.

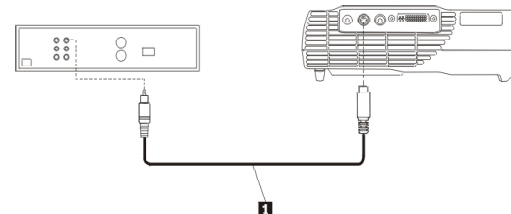

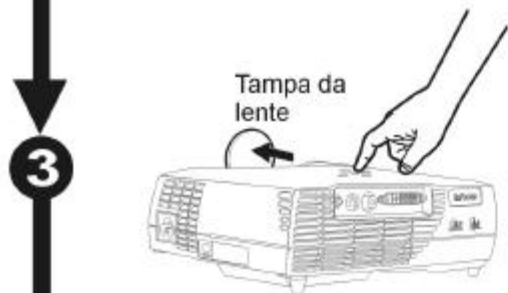
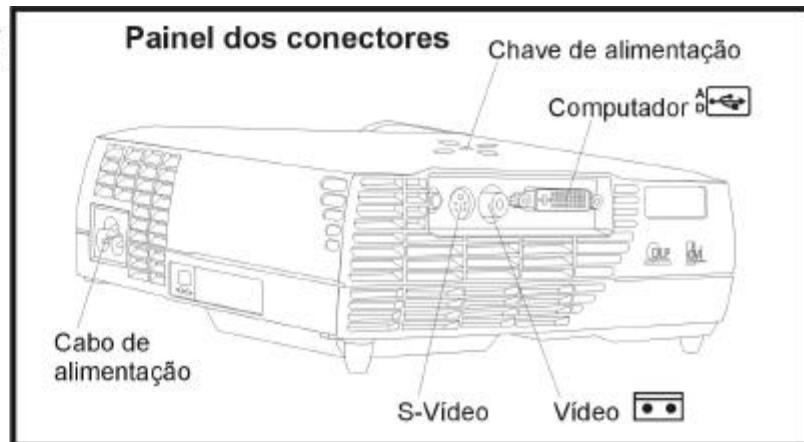

Para exibir o *Guia do Usuário* online em vários idiomas, referente ao Projetor iLM300 MicroPortable no CD, proceda da seguinte maneira:

1. Insira o *CD do Guia do Usuário* na unidade de CD-ROM.
2. O CD será iniciado. Vá para a etapa 5. Se o CD não for iniciado, clique em **Iniciar** e, em seguida, clique em **Executar**.
3. Digite **e: \1 aunch. bat**, onde e: é a unidade de CD-ROM.

Ajuda Adicional

O *Guia do Usuário* do iLM300 inclui instruções abrangentes sobre a configuração e a operação do projetor. Aqui, você encontrará alguns problemas comuns de configuração e a maneira de resolvê-los.

1. Nada aparece na tela.

Certifique-se de ter conectado o cabo de alimentação, de ter removido a tampa da lente e de que o botão liga/desliga na parte superior do projetor foi pressionado.

2. Tudo o que vejo é a tela de inicialização.

Certifique-se de que o cabo do computador esteja conectado entre o computador e o projetor. Tente pressionar as teclas de ativação do computador móvel mais uma vez. Algumas máquinas exigem que as teclas sejam pressionadas duas vezes para ativar a imagem.

Verifique se você está utilizando a combinação correta de teclas de ativação referente a seu computador. O Apêndice C no *Guia do Usuário* online contém uma lista de combinações de teclas para vários computadores móveis.

3. Não há imagem do computador na tela.

O projetor pode não estar sincronizado com o sinal do computador. Pressione o botão Menu no teclado do projetor ou no controle remoto para abrir os menus. No menu Basic, selecione **Reset** para sincronizar as definições do projetor com o computador. Consulte o Capítulo 2 no

Guia do Usuário online para obter mais informações sobre como ajustar as definições da imagem com os menus na tela.

4. A imagem preenche a tela, mas o texto fica impreciso e difícil de ser lido.

Defina a resolução de vídeo do computador móvel para a resolução do projetor, que é de 1024x768. Se a resolução do computador móvel for somente 800x600 ou 640x480, o projetor converterá automaticamente a resolução para 1024x768.

Ajuste o anel de foco e o de zoom para obter uma imagem mais definida.

5. Só consigo ver parte da imagem do computador na tela.

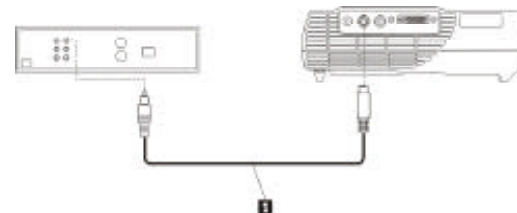

オンライン・ユーザズ・ガイドの表示方法

CDに入っているマルチ・ランゲージのiLM300 マイクロポータブル・プロジェクター II ユーザーズ・ガイドを表示するには、次の手順で行います。

1. *User Guide CD*をCD-ROM ドライブに挿入します。
2. CDが起動します。ステップ5に進みます。起動しない場合は、「スタート」→「ファイル名を指定して実行」をクリックします。
3. 「e:\engage.bat」(e は CD-ROM ドライブ)と入力します。
4. 「OK」をクリックします。CDブラウザのページが表示されます。
5. 画面に表示される指示に従います。

追加ヘルプ情報

iLM300 ユーザーズ・ガイドには、ご使用のプロジェクターをセットアップしたり、操作したりするための詳しい手順が記載されています。次に、セットアップの際によく起きる問題とその解決策を記述します。

1. スクリーンに何も映らない。

電源コードがつながっていること、レンズ・キャップが外されていること、そしてプロジェクター上部の電源スイッチが入っていることを確認します。

2. スタートアップ画面しか表示されない。

コンピューターとプロジェクターの間のケーブルが接続されていることを確認します。ノートブック・コンピューターのファンクション・キーを再度押してみます。画像を映すには、そのキーを2回押す必要がある場合があります。

ご使用のコンピューターのファンクション・キーの正しい組み合わせを使用していることを確認します。ノートブック・コンピューターのファンクション・キーのリストが、オンライン・ユーザズ・ガイドの『付録 C』に記載されています。

3. スクリーンにコンピューター画面が表示されない。

プロジェクターがコンピューター信号と同期がとれていません。プロジェクターのキーパッドまたはリモコンの Menu (メニュー) ボタンを押して、メニューを開きます。「Basic」メニューから「Reset」を選択し、プロジェクターの設定をコンピューターに同期させます。オンスクリーン・メニューでの画像設定の調整については、オンライン・ユーザズ・ガイドの『第2章』を参照してください。

4. 画像がスクリーンに表示されるが、文字がぼやけて読みづらい。ノートブック・コンピューターの解像度をプロジェクターの解像度の1024x768に合わせます。ご使用のノートブック・コンピューターの解像度が800x600または640x680のみの場合には、プロジェクターが自動的に解像度を1024x768に変換します。

フォーカス・リングとズーム・リングを使用して、くっきりした画像になるように調整します。

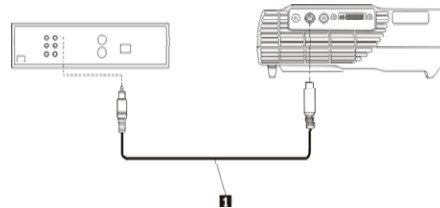

Part 1 - General Terms

This Statement of Limited Warranty includes Part 1 - General Terms and Part 2 - Country-unique Terms. The terms of Part 2 replace or modify those of Part 1. The warranties provided by IBM in this Statement of Limited Warranty apply only to Machines you purchase for your use, and not for resale, from IBM or your reseller. The term "Machine" means an IBM machine, its features, conversions, upgrades, elements, or accessories, or any combination of them. The term "Machine" does not include any software programs, whether pre-loaded with the Machine, installed subsequently or otherwise. Unless IBM specifies otherwise, the following warranties apply only in the country where you acquire the Machine. Nothing in this Statement of Limited Warranty affects any statutory rights of consumers that cannot be waived or limited by contract. If you have any questions, contact IBM or your reseller.

The IBM Warranty for Machines: IBM warrants that each Machine 1) is free from defects in materials and workmanship and 2) conforms to IBM's Official Published Specifications ("Specifications"). The warranty period for a Machine is a specified, fixed period commencing on its Date of Installation. The date on your sales receipt is the Date of Installation unless IBM or your reseller informs you otherwise.

If a Machine does not function as warranted during the warranty period, and IBM or your reseller are unable to either 1) make it do so or 2) replace it with one that is at least functionally equivalent, you may return it to your place of purchase and your money will be refunded.

Extent of Warranty: The warranty does not cover the repair or exchange of a Machine resulting from misuse, accident, modification, unsuitable physical or operating environment, improper maintenance by you, or failure caused by a product for which IBM is not responsible. The warranty is voided by removal or alteration of Machine or parts identification labels.

THESE WARRANTIES ARE YOUR EXCLUSIVE WARRANTIES AND REPLACE ALL OTHER WARRANTIES OR CONDITIONS, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OR CONDITIONS OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. THESE WARRANTIES GIVE YOU SPECIFIC LEGAL RIGHTS AND YOU MAY ALSO HAVE OTHER RIGHTS WHICH VARY FROM JURISDICTION TO JURISDICTION. SOME JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW THE EXCLUSION OR LIMITATION OF EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, SO THE ABOVE EXCLUSION OR LIMITATION MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU. IN THAT EVENT, SUCH WARRANTIES ARE LIMITED IN DURATION TO THE WARRANTY PERIOD. NO WARRANTIES APPLY AFTER THAT PERIOD.

Items Not Covered by Warranty: IBM does not warrant uninterrupted or error-free operation of a Machine.

Any technical or other support provided for a Machine under warranty, such as assistance via telephone with "how-to" questions and those regarding Machine set-up and installation, will be provided **WITHOUT WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND.**

Warranty Service: To obtain warranty service for a Machine, contact IBM or your reseller. If you do not register your Machine with IBM, you may be required to present proof of purchase.

During the warranty period, IBM or your reseller, if approved by IBM to provide warranty service, provides without charge certain types of repair and exchange service to keep Machines in, or restore them to, conformance with their Specifications. IBM or your reseller will inform you of the available types of service for a Machine based on its country of installation. At its discretion, IBM or your reseller will 1) either repair or exchange the failing Machine and 2) provide the service either at your location or a service center. The replacement assumes the warranty service status of the replaced item. Many features, conversions, or upgrades involve the removal of parts and their return to IBM. A part that replaces a removed part will assume the warranty service status of the removed part.

Before IBM or your reseller exchanges a Machine or part, you agree to remove all features, parts, options, alterations, and attachments not under warranty service.

You also agree to

- ensure that the Machine is free of any legal obligations or restrictions that prevent its exchange;

- obtain authorization from the owner to have IBM or your reseller service a Machine that you do not own; and

- where applicable, before service is provided:

 - follow the problem determination, problem analysis, and service request procedures that IBM or your reseller provides; secure all programs, data, and funds contained in a Machine;

 - provide IBM or your reseller with sufficient, free, and safe access to your facilities to permit them to fulfill their obligations; and

 - inform IBM or your reseller of changes in a Machine's location.

IBM is responsible for loss of, or damage to, your Machine while it is 1) in IBM's possession or 2) in transit in those cases where IBM is responsible for the transportation charges.

Neither IBM nor your reseller is responsible for any of your confidential, proprietary or personal information contained in a Machine which you return to IBM or your reseller for any reason. You should remove all such information from the Machine prior to its return.

Limitation of Liability: Circumstances may arise where, because of a default on IBM's part or other liability, you are entitled to recover damages from IBM. In each such instance, regardless of the basis on which you are entitled to claim damages from IBM (including fundamental breach, negligence, misrepresentation, or other contract or tort claim), except for any liability that cannot be waived or limited by applicable laws, IBM is liable for no more than

damages for bodily injury (including death) and damage to real property and tangible personal property; and

the amount of any other actual direct damages, up to the charges (if recurring, 12 months' charges apply) for the Machine that is subject of the claim. For purposes of this item, the term "Machine" includes Machine Code and Licensed Internal Code.

This limit also applies to IBM's suppliers and your reseller. It is the maximum for which IBM, its suppliers, and your reseller are collectively responsible.

The IBM Warranty for Machines: *The following paragraph is added to this Section:*

The warranties specified in this Section are in addition to any rights you may have under the Trade Practices Act 1974 or other similar legislation and are only limited to the extent permitted by the applicable legislation.

Limitation of Liability: *The following is added to this Section:*

Where IBM is in breach of a condition or warranty implied by the Trade Practices Act 1974 or other similar legislation, IBM's liability is limited to the repair or replacement of the goods or the supply of equivalent goods. The arbitrator or arbitrators designated in conformity with those rules shall have the power to rule on their own competence and on the validity of the Agreement to submit to arbitration. The arbitration award shall be final and binding for the parties without appeal and the arbitral award shall be in writing and set forth the findings of fact and the conclusions of law.

All proceedings shall be conducted, including all documents presented in such proceedings, in the English language. The number of arbitrators shall be three, with each side to the dispute being entitled to appoint one arbitrator.

The two arbitrators appointed by the parties shall appoint a third arbitrator before proceeding upon the reference. The third arbitrator shall act as chairman of the proceedings. If one of the parties refuses or otherwise fails to appoint an arbitrator within 30 days of the date the other party appoints its, the first appointed arbitrator shall be the sole arbitrator, provided that the arbitrator was validly and properly appointed.

The English language version of this Agreement prevails over any other language version.

Both you and IBM consent to the application of the laws of the State of New York (except when local law requires otherwise) to govern, interpret, and enforce all your and IBM's rights, duties, and obligations arising from, or relating in any manner to, the subject matter of this Agreement, without regard to conflict of law principles.

Any disputes arising from or in connection with this Agreement will first be resolved by friendly negotiations, failing which either of us has the right to submit the dispute to the China International Economic and Trade Arbitration Commission in Beijing, the PRC, for arbitration in accordance with its arbitration rules in force at the time. The arbitration tribunal will consist of three arbitrators. The language to be used therein will be English and Chinese. An arbitral award will be final and binding on all the parties, and will be enforceable under the Convention on the Recognition and Enforcement of Foreign Arbitral Awards (1958).

The arbitration fee will be borne by the losing party unless otherwise determined by the arbitral award.

During the course of arbitration, this Agreement will continue to be performed except for the part which the parties are disputing and which is undergoing arbitration.

EUROPE, MIDDLE EAST, AFRICA (EMEA)

THE FOLLOWING TERMS APPLY TO ALL EMEA COUNTRIES:

The terms of this Statement of Limited Warranty apply to Machines purchased from IBM or an IBM reseller.

The applicable laws that govern, interpret and enforce rights, duties, and obligations of each of us arising from, or relating in any manner to, the subject matter of this Statement, without regard to conflict of laws principles, as well as Country-unique terms and competent court for this Statement are those of the country in which the warranty service is being provided, except that in 1) Albania, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Hungary, Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Moldova, Russia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, and Uzbekistan, the laws of Austria apply; 2) Estonia, Latvia, and Lithuania, the laws of Finland apply; 3) Algeria, Benin, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Cape Verde, Central African Republic, Chad, Congo, Djibouti, Democratic Republic of Congo, Equatorial Guinea, France, Gabon, Gambia, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Ivory Coast, Lebanon, Mali, Mauritania, Morocco, Niger, Senegal, Togo, and Tunisia, this Agreement will be construed and the legal relations between the parties will be determined in accordance with the French laws and all disputes arising out of this Agreement or related to its violation or execution, including summary proceedings, will be settled exclusively by the Commercial Court of Paris; 4) Angola, Bahrain, Botswana, Burundi, Egypt, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Ghana, Jordan, Kenya, Kuwait, Liberia, Malawi, Malta, Mozambique, Nigeria, Oman, Pakistan, Qatar, Rwanda, Sao Tome, Saudi Arabia, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Tanzania, Uganda, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom, West Bank/Gaza, Yemen, Zambia, and Zimbabwe, this Agreement will be governed by English Law and disputes relating to it will be submitted to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts; and 5) in Greece, Israel, Italy, Portugal, and Spain any legal claim arising out of this Statement will be brought before, and finally settled by, the competent court of Athens, Tel Aviv, Milan, Lisbon, and Madrid, respectively.

Applicability of suppliers and resellers (unchanged).

The following paragraph is added at the end of this Section:

IBM's entire liability and your sole remedy, whether in contract or in tort, in respect of any default shall be limited to damages.

ITALY

Limitation of Liability: *The following replaces the second sentence in the first paragraph:*

In each such instance unless otherwise provided by mandatory law, IBM is liable for no more than:

1. *(unchanged)*
2. as to any other actual damage arising in all situations involving nonperformance by IBM pursuant to, or in any way related to the subject matter of this Statement of Warranty, IBM's liability, will be limited to the total amount you paid for the Machine that is the subject of the claim.

Applicability of suppliers and resellers (unchanged).

The following replaces the third paragraph of this Section:

Unless otherwise provided by mandatory law, IBM and your reseller are not liable for any of the following: *(items 1 and 2 unchanged)* 3) indirect damages, even if IBM or your reseller is informed of their possibility.

SOUTH AFRICA, NAMIBIA, BOTSWANA, LESOTHO AND SWAZILAND

Limitation of Liability: *The following is added to this Section:*

IBM's entire liability to you for actual damages arising in all situations involving nonperformance by IBM in respect of the subject matter of this Statement of Warranty will be limited to the charge paid by you for the individual Machine that is the subject of your claim from IBM.

UNITED KINGDOM

Limitation of Liability: *The following replaces items 1 and 2 of the first paragraph of this Section:*

death or personal injury or physical damage to your real property solely caused by IBM's negligence;

the amount of any other actual direct damages or loss, up to 125 percent of the charges (if recurring, the 12 months' charges apply) for the Machine that is the subject of the claim or which otherwise gives rise to the claim;

The following item is added to this paragraph:

3. breach of IBM's obligations implied by Section 12 of the Sale of Goods Act 1979 or Section 2 of the Supply of Goods and Services Act 1982.

Applicability of suppliers and resellers (unchanged).

The following is added to the end of this Section:

IBM's entire liability and your sole remedy, whether in contract or in tort, in respect of any default shall be limited to damages.
