- Display the input source menu.

- Display main MENU.
- 3. CH+/CH-In TV mode, press "CH+" or "CH-" to change the channel up and down.
 - In MENU mode, press "CH+" or "CH-" to select items. In standby mode, press "CH+" or "CH-" to turn on the TV.
- 4. VOL+/VOL-
- Adjust sound level.
- In MENU mode, press "VOL+" or "VOL-" to adjust the item that you selected. 5. STANDBY
- Press this button to turn the unit ON from STANDBY mode. Press it again to turn the set back to STANDBY.
- 6. USB

The USB memory stick should be plug in the unit directly. USB extension cable should not be used to avoid failing of data transferring and interference caused.

Insert Batteries Into the Remote Control



- 1. Remove the battery cover.
- 2. Inserting the 2 AAA 1.5V batteries making sure the polarity (+ or -) of the batteries matches the polarity marks inside the unit.

 Mount the battery cover. Replace with new batteries when the TV set begins to show the following symptoms: Operation is unsteady or erratic. Sometimes the TV set does not function with Remote Control Unit. Remark:

1) Alkaline Battery Recommended.

2) Remove batteries when they are exhausted or if the remote control is not to be used for long time.

1. CHANNEL MENU

The first item of the MENU is channel menu (for TV source only).

You can search channels and edit programs here. Press ▼▲ to move, press OK button to confirm, and press ◀► to adjust.



1).Auto tuning:

Search all the TV channels automatically.

2). Manual tuning:

You can change the sound system to search the TV channels and fine tune the channels, then storage the channels you selected.




NOTE:

Press teletext red button to storage to channels after manual tuning.

3). Program Edit:

You can Delete, Rename, Move, or Skipany programs.



elete Delete

Press teletext redbutton, it will shows red delete cursor.

Press $\checkmark \blacktriangle$ to choose the program.

Press red button again, the program will delete.



Rename

Move the cursor to the program, press teletext green button to rename the program. Press ▼▲ to choose the character. Press ◀► to move the cursor.

Press MENU button to exit edit, Press EXIT to exit the menu.

Note: The TV programs name only can be 5 characters.

Move Move

Move the cursor to the program, press teletext yellow button, it will show yellow cursor, Press ▼▲ to move the program.



Press \checkmark to choose the program, press teletext blue button to skip this program, The icon (()) will show on the right side of the program. Choose the skipped program, press the blue button again, you can cancel the skip, Then the icon (()) will disappear.

4). Software update(USB):

Update the TV set's software by USB.

2. PICTURE MENU

The second item of the MENU is PICTURE MENU. You can adjust picture effect here, such as contrast, brightness, etc.

Press $\checkmark \land$ to move, press OK button to confirm, and press $\checkmark \lor$ to adjust.



NOTE:

 Tint is available in NTSC system only.
There are four color temperature modes can be selected, such as medium, warm, cool, and user.

3).Screen is available in PC mode only, which can adjust horizontal position, vertical position, size and phase.



3. SOUND MENU

The third item of the MENU is the SOUND MENU.

You can adjust the sound effect here such as treble, bass, balance etc.

Press $\checkmark \land$ to move, press OK button to confirm, and press $\triangleleft \succ$ to adjust.



Note:

Auto volume: only available when the input signal volume is too large or distortion. EQ: Amplify the selected sound frequency as you wish.

4. TIME MENU

The forth item of the menuis the TIMEMENU You can adjust the clock, power on/off time, sleep time etc.

Press $\checkmark \land$ to move, press OK button to confirm, and press $\checkmark \lor$ to adjust.



NOTE:

Within 15 minutes there is no signal, the TV will auto sleep.

Once you power off the TVset by AC, the clock time will be reset.

5.OPTION MENU

The fifth item of the MENU is the OPTIONMENU. You can adjust the OSD language or Restore factory default.



NOTE:


Restore factory default will clear all the programs and Reset all the settings to default value.

6. APPLICATIONMENU

The sixth item of the MENU is the APPLICATION MENU.



Press OK button to enter the USB menu.




Please make sure that the USB device have plugged in the slot. There are four type media item can be selected, such as photo, music, Movie and text. Select the type media item by pressing $\langle \cdot \rangle$, press **OK** button to enter the disk selection menu.

In the movie mode, when you use FB, FF function, The audio may be pause in several seconds to synchronize the audio signal and video signal.


In text mode, press ◀ ▶ to makepage up and page down.

NOTE:

When the USB device isn't supported, it may be that the power of the USB device isn't enough.



Press the ◀► to select the right disk and press **OK** to display media files and folder list or choose Return to back to the media type selection menu.



Select the media file by pressing $\blacktriangleleft \triangleright$ or $\checkmark \blacktriangle$, then the preview frame will pop up. Press the button \triangleright to play the media file in full screen. When the media file (photo, music, Movie or text type) is playing, press the **OK** or Info button can display the control bar.



Music function need to put music and picture in the same folder.



Press $\triangleleft \triangleright$ to select the function icon, press OK button to confirm the function.

Press \checkmark or EXIT button to exit the control bar. **NOTE:**

You can adjust the audio track, subtitle, or program in the Info menu while Playing the video file. Choose the Info icon and press OK can display the Info MENU.
