Installing the Stand

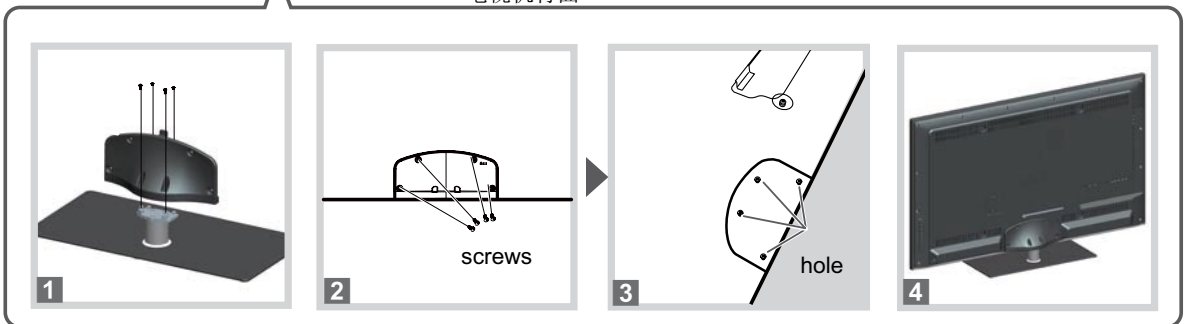


Step 1 : Connect the guide stand to the stand using 4 screws(M 4X8) as shown.

Step 2 : Remove 4 EA screws on back of TV as shown in picture.

Step 3: Put the stand base on the slot of display bottom; Finally fix 4 screws(M 4X12) in accessory to the right position as shown in picture.

Step 4: Stand assembly is finished.



Wall Mounting Installation

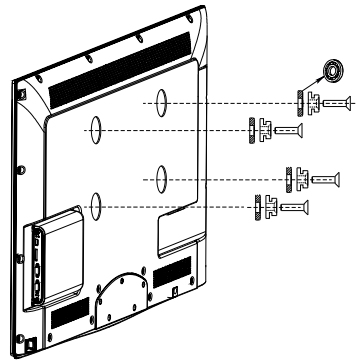
Preparing before installing Wall-Mount.

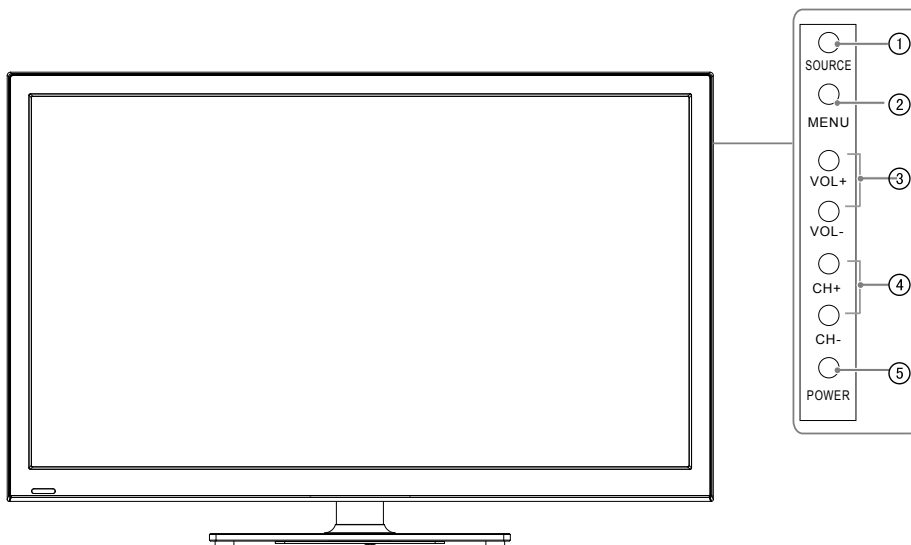


Installing Wall-Mount kit

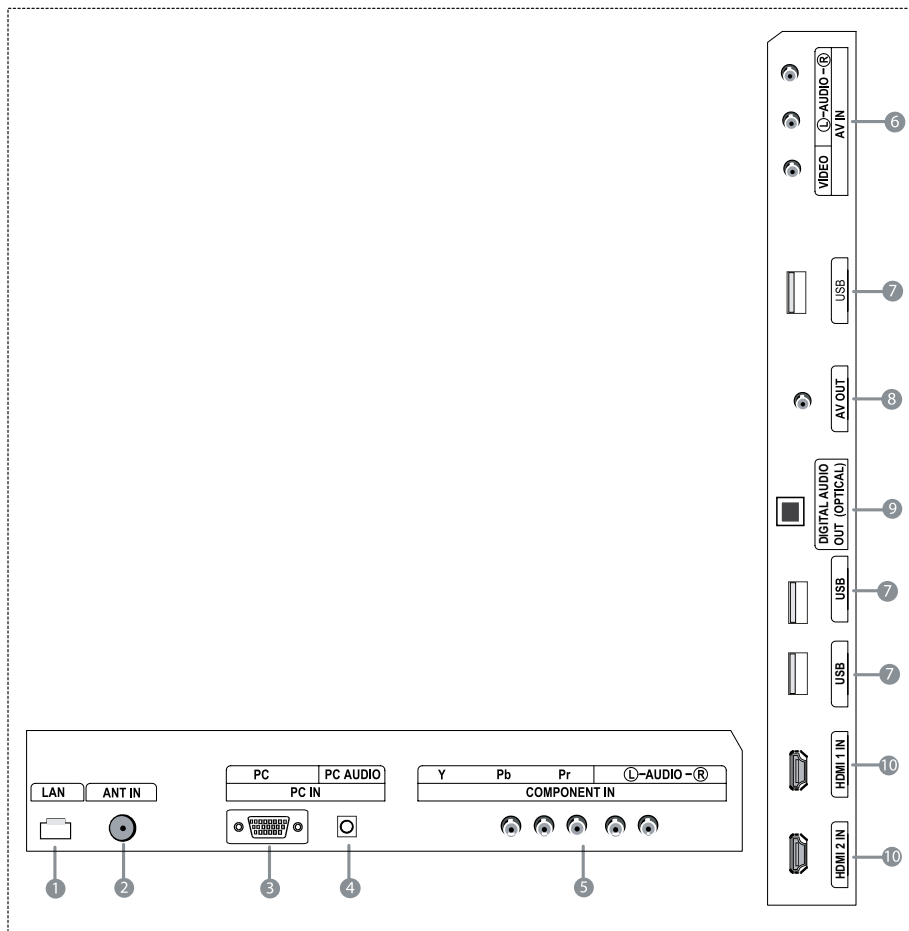

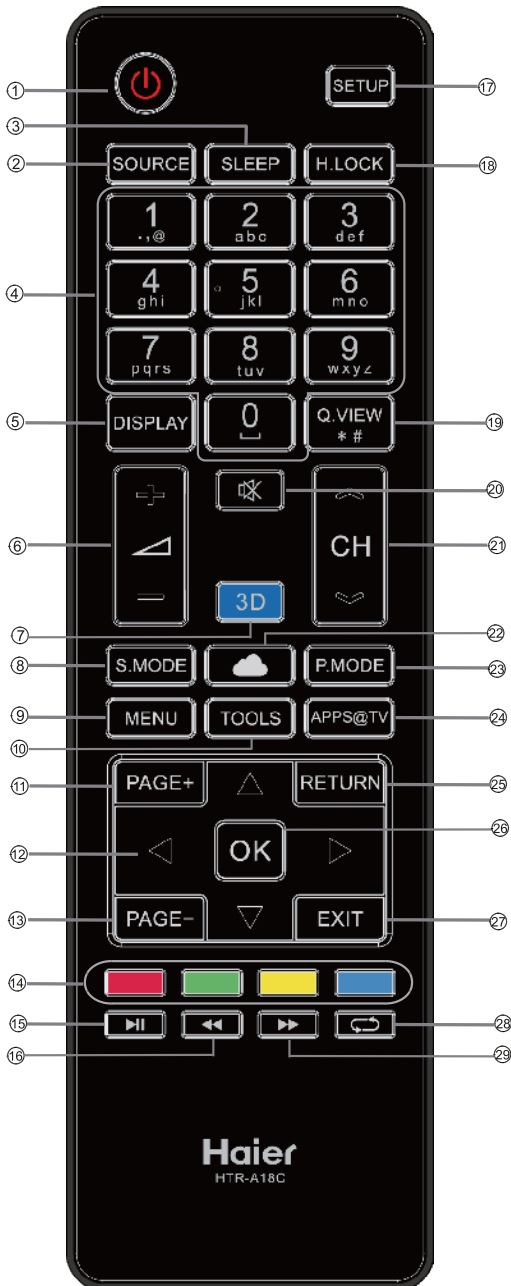

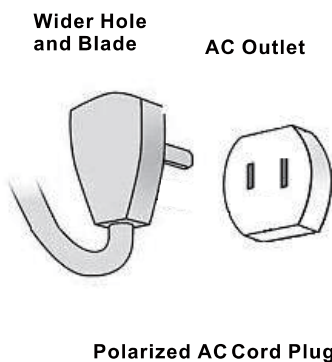
Power source

To use AC Power Supply

Use the AC polarized line cord provided for operation on AC. Insert the AC cord plug into a standard polarized AC outlet.

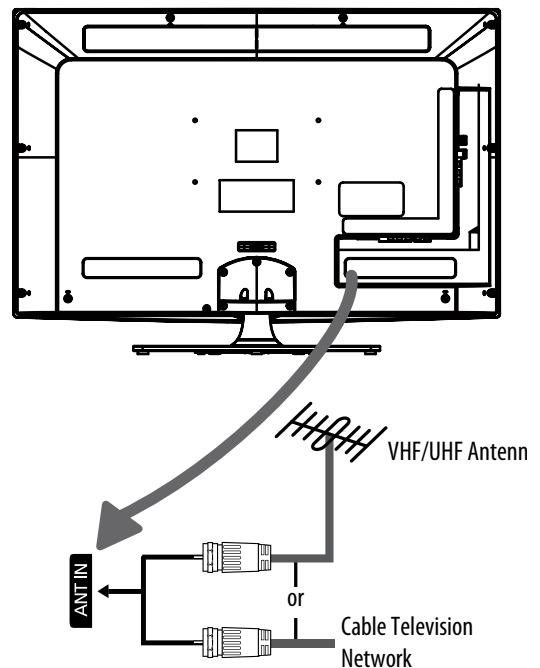
Note

- Never connect the AC line cord plug to other than the specified voltage. Use the attached power cord only.
- If the polarized AC cord does not fit into a non-polarized AC outlet, do not attempt to file or cut the blade. It is the user's responsibility to have an electrician replace the obsolete outlet.
- If you cause a static discharge when touching the unit and the unit fails to function, simply unplug the unit from the AC outlet and plug it back in. The unit should return to normal operation.



Connecting to an Antenna or Cable Connection

Over-the-air TV reception quality will depend on your antenna type, antenna location and antenna positioning.



Note

- To improve the picture quality in a poor signal area, please purchase a signal amplifier and install properly.
- If the antenna needs to be split for two TV's, install a "2-Way Signal Splitter".
- When you move or swivel the TV with Antenna cable tightly connected, there is high risk antenna jack on TV will be broken off.

Choose Your Connection

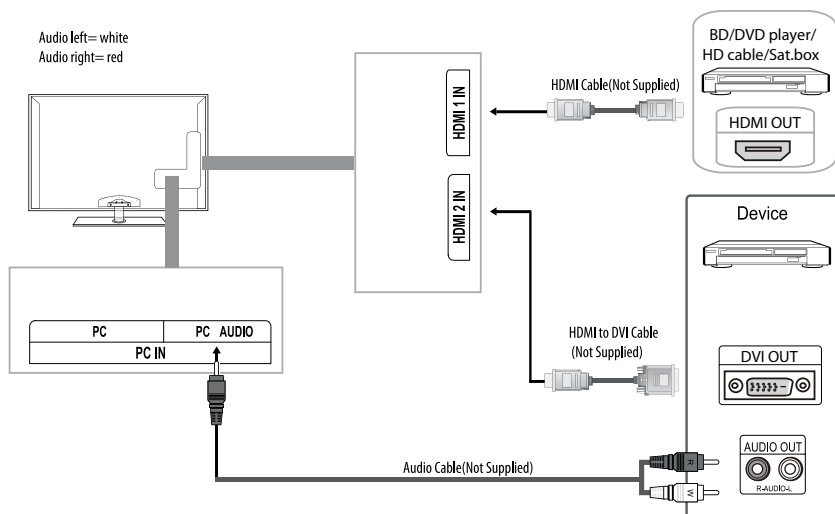
There are several ways to connect your television, depending on the components you want to connect and the quality of the signal you want to achieve. The following are examples of some different ways to connect your TV with different input sources.

Connecting to HDMI Device

Using an HDMI or HDMI/DVI Cable: HD connection(up to 1080p)

We recommend using the HDMI connection for the best quality HD picture.

Available devices: DVD player, Blu-ray player, HD cable box, HD satellite receiver(STB).



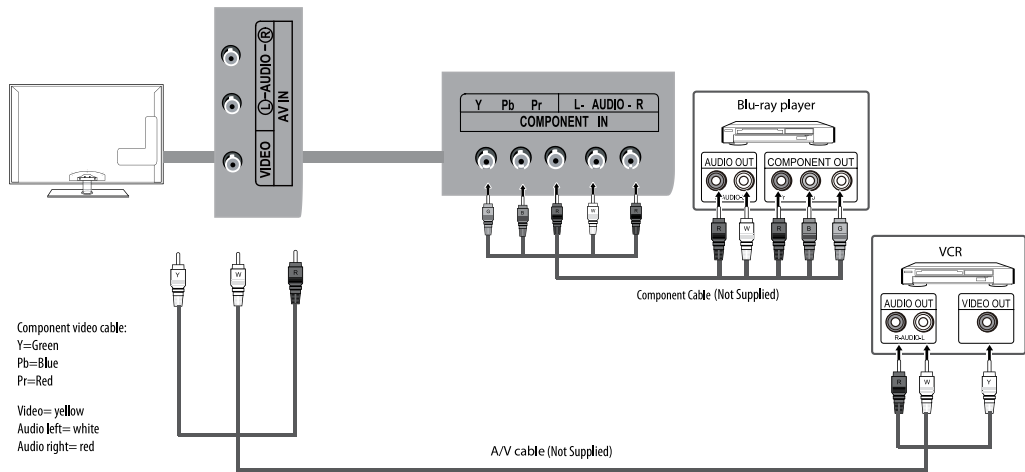
HDMI IN PC AUDIO IN

- 1 When using an HDMI/DVI cable connection, you must use the **HDMI IN** jack for video. A DVD player, Blu-ray player, HD cable box, HD satellite receiver (STB), cable box, or STB satellite receiver may require a DVI-HDMI (DVI to HDMI) cable or DVI-HDMI (DVI to HDMI) adapter. You must use the PC/DVI AUDIO IN jack for audio.
- 2 The picture may not display normally (if at all) or the audio may not work if you connect an external device that uses an older version of HDMI mode to the TV. If such a problem occurs, ask the manufacturer of the external device about the HDMI version and, if out of date, request an upgrade.
- 3 Be sure to purchase a certified HDMI cable. Otherwise, the picture may not display or a connection error may occur.

Connecting to an AV Device

Using a Component(up to 1080p) or an Audio/Video Cable

Available devices: DVD player,Blu-ray player,cable box,STB satellite receiver,VCR

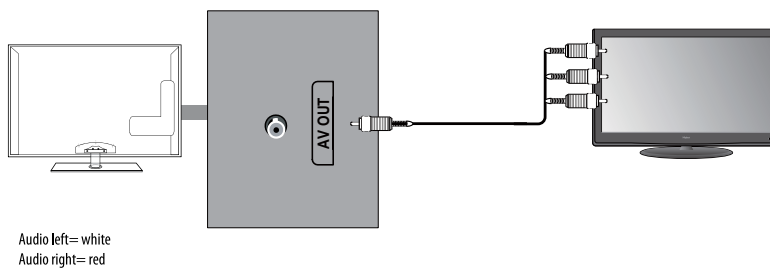


Note

- For better picture quality, the Component connection is recommended over the A/V connection.

AV OUT: Connects to the audio input jacks on your amplifier/home theater

- 1 When connecting, use the appropriate connector (included with your TV).
- 2 When you connect an audio amplifier to the AV OUT jacks: Decrease the volume of the TV and adjust the volume level with the Amplifier's volume control.

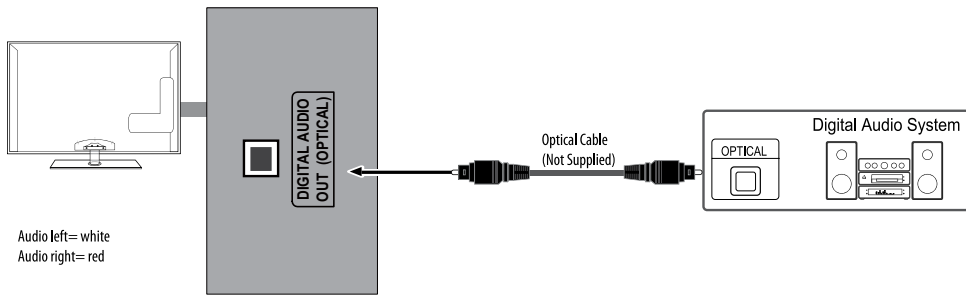


Connecting to an Audio Device

Using an Optical(Digital) or Audio(Analog) Cable Connection

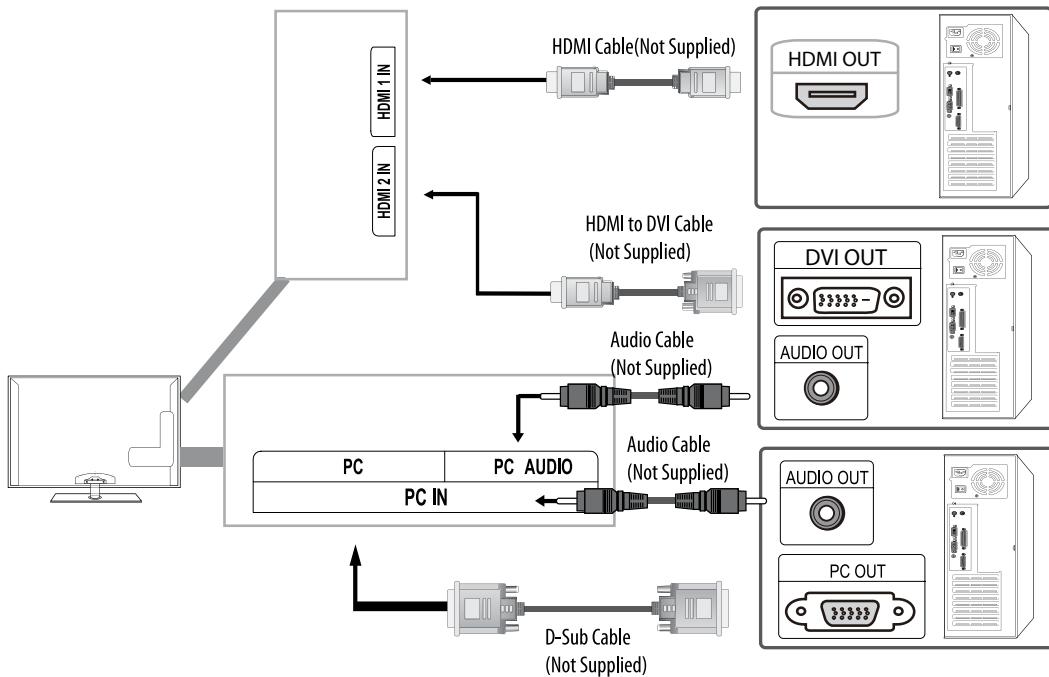
Available devices: Digital Audio System, Amplifier, Home Theater.

When you connect a Digital Audio System to the DIGITAL AUDIO OUT (OPTICAL) jack: Decrease the volume of both TV and the system.

Basic Receiving and Playing Operations

Switching ON/OFF the

TV set

In the manual, the OSD (on screen display) may be different from your TV's because it is just an example to help you with the TV operation.

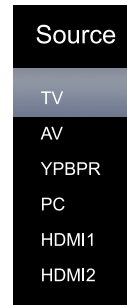
Switching ON/OFF the TV set

- 1** First, connect power cord correctly and the power indicator will light.
- 2** Press **POWER** on the remote control.
- 3** If you want to exchange to standing by status, please press down **POWER** on the remote control
- 4** Disconnect the power supply or unplug the television if it is intended to completely cease the television performance.

Choose the Input source

Use to select TV or an external input source such as a DVD player/Blu-ray player/cable box/STB satellite receiver.

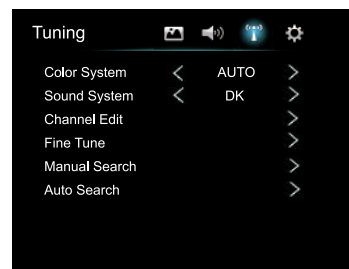
- 1** Press **SOURCE** button to enter the Input Source menu and then use **▲ ▼** button to select the desired external input source (TV, AV, YPBPR, PC, HDMI1, HDMI2).
- 2** Press **OK** button to confirm .



Tuning Your TV

Display Tuning menu by pressing **SOURCE** button then use **▲ ▼** button to select the source of TV .

- 1** Press **MENU** button and then use **◀ ▶** button to select **Tuning** menu. press **OK** to enter.
- 2** Press **▲ ▼** button to select the desired items, press **OK** to enter its submenu.



Color System

- 1** Press **MENU** button , Press **◀ ▶** button to select **Tuning**, press **OK** to enter its submenu.
- 2** Press **▲ ▼** button to select **Color System**, Press **◀ ▶** button to select **PAL/NTSC/SECAM/AUTO**.
- 3** Press **RETURN** button to return to the previous menu, press **EXIT** button to exit the menu screen.

Sound System

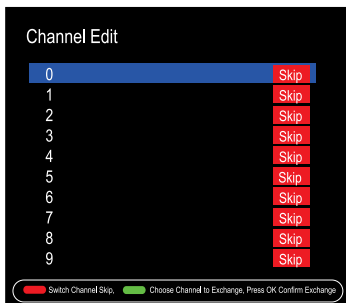
- 1** Press **MENU** button , Press **◀ ▶** button to select **Tuning**, press **OK** to enter its submenu.
- 2** Press **▲ ▼** button to select **Sound System**, Press **◀ ▶** button to select **DK/I/BG/M**.

- 3 Press **RETURN** button to return to the previous menu, press **EXIT** button to exit the menu screen.

Channel Edit

You can add a label to a channel to make it easier to find.

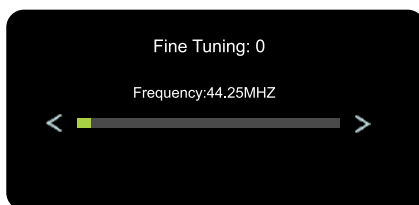
- 1 Press **MENU** button and then use **◀ ▶** button to select **Tuning** menu. press **OK** to enter its submenu.
- 2 Press **▲ ▼** button to select the **Channel Edit**, press **OK** to enter its submenu.



- 3 Press **▲ ▼** button to select the channel you want to edit . Press the **GREEN** button on the remote control, Choose the other Channels to Exchange, Press **OK** Confirm Exchange. If select the **RED** button ,the channel with a check icon is a skipped channel. Press **OK** button to display "please Input Channel Name", Select OK or Cancel. Press **EXIT** button to return to the previous menu.

Fine Tune

- 1 Press **MENU** button and then use **◀ ▶** button to select **Tuning** menu. press **OK** to enter its submenu.
- 2 Press **▲ ▼** button to select **Fine Tune**, Press **OK** button on the remote to enter its submenu.

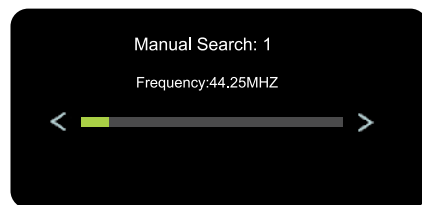


- 3 Press **◀ ▶** button to select your desired Frequency.

- 4 Press **EXIT** button to exit menu screen.

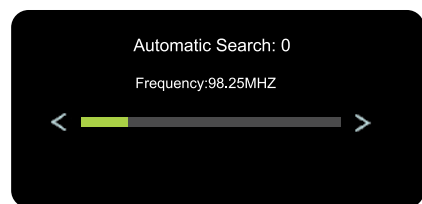
Manual Search

- 1 Press **MENU** button and then use **◀ ▶** button to select **Tuning** menu. press **OK** to enter its submenu.
- 2 Press **▲ ▼** button to select **Manual Search** , press **OK** to enter its submenu.
- 3 Press **◀ ▶** button to adjust the Frequency.
- 4 Press **MENU** button to return to the previous menu, press **EXIT** button to exit the menu screen.



Auto Search

- 1 Press **MENU** button and then use **◀ ▶** button to select **Tuning** menu. press **OK** to enter its submenu.
- 2 Press **▲ ▼** button to select **Auto Search**, Press **OK** button on the remote to start to scan.
- 3 Press **MENU** button to return to the previous menu, press **EXIT** button to exit the menu screen.



All channels now available will be automatically preset in older .After the search has finished, the first program number will display on the screen.

This search automatically adds only the active channels in your area to the TV's memory.

It deletes any channels on which there is no broadcast or a poor signal.


The channels found are automatically saved.

Using Your TV

How to Select the TV Program

- Using Program number button Enter the channel number with the number keypad on the remote control.
- Using **CH \wedge /CH \vee** button.
Press the **CH \wedge /CH \vee** button to select a channel number.

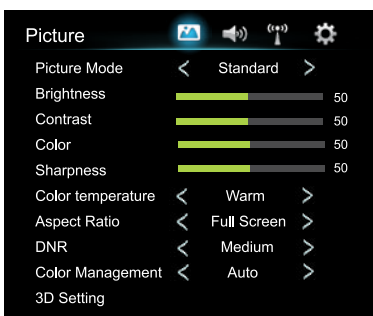
How to Adjust Volume

Press  button on the remote control or the keypad on the TV to adjust the volume level.

Adjusting Picture Settings

Changing the Picture Setting

- Press **MENU** button, then press $\leftarrow \rightarrow$ button to select **Picture**, press **OK** button to enter.



- Press $\uparrow \downarrow$ button to select the item which requires to be adjusted.
- Press $\leftarrow \rightarrow$ button to adjust the selected item.
- When you are satisfied with your choice, press the **EXIT** button to return to normal viewing or press **RETURN** button to return to the previous menu.

❖ Picture Mode

This will select the picture mode. Select **Standard/Vivid/Soft/User**, according to the program.

❖ Brightness

This will adjust the light output of the complete picture, which will mainly affect the darker areas of the picture.

❖ Contrast

This will adjust the intensity of bright parts in the picture but keep the dark parts unchanged.

❖ Color

This will adjust the saturation level of the colors to suit your personal preference.

❖ Sharpness

This will adjust the sharpness of fine details in the picture.

❖ Color temperature

Press $\leftarrow \rightarrow$ button to set Color temperature as **Standard, Cool, Warm**.

This will increase or decrease **Warm** (red) and **Cool** (blue) colors to suit personal preferences. Select **Cool** to give the white color a blue tint, **Standard** to give the white color a natural tint, **Warm** to give the white color a red tint.

❖ Aspect Ratio

Press $\leftarrow \rightarrow$ button to set Advanced Ratio as **Panorama, Cinema, Zoom, JUST SCAN, FULL SCREEN, 4:3**.

❖ DNR

Press $\leftarrow \rightarrow$ button to set DNR as **AUTO, High, Off, Low, Medium**.

❖ Color Management

Press $\leftarrow \rightarrow$ button to set Colour Management as **Auto, On, Off**.

❖ 3D Setting

Ensure you read and understand the following safety information before using the TV's 3D function.



Note

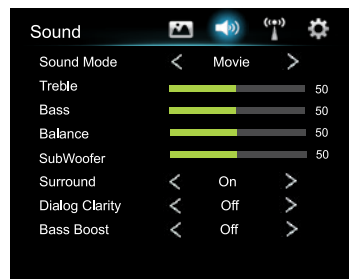
- Some people may experience discomfort, such as dizziness, nausea and headaches, while viewing 3D TV. If you experience any such symptom, stop watching 3D TV, remove the 3D glasses and have a rest.
- Watching 3D images for an extended period of time may cause eye strain. If you feel that your eyes are becoming strained, stop watching 3D TV, remove your 3D glasses and have a rest.
- Do not allow children under 6 years old to view 3D images. A responsible adult should frequently check on children who are using the 3D function. If there are any reports of tired eyes, headaches, dizziness or nausea, stop the child from watching 3D TV and have a rest.
- Do not use the 3D glasses for other purposes (such as general spectacles, sunglasses, protective glasses etc.)
- Do not use the 3D function or 3D glasses while walking or moving around. If you use the 3D function or 3D glasses while walking or moving around you may run into objects, trip and/or fall and injure yourself.
- Do not drop, exert pressure on or step on the 3D glasses.
- Do not use the 3D glasses if they are cracked or broken.

- The TV doesn't store the 3D mode settings, so if you switch it off, it will return to 2D mode when turned back on again.
- In USB mode, there are various modes of 3D video sources. With USB signals, the 3D switch key only functions when playing a film. The TV will exit 3D mode when the film finished or when you manually exit 3D mode.

Adjusting Sound Setting

Changing the Sound Setting

- 1 Press **MENU** button.
- 2 Press **◀ ▶** button to select **Sound**, press **OK** button to enter.
- 3 Press **▲ ▼** button to select the item which require to be adjusted.
- 4 Press **◀ ▶** button to adjust the selection item.



- 5 When you are satisfied with your choice, press the **EXIT** button to return to normal viewing or press **RETURN** button to return to the previous menu.

❖ **Sound Mode**

This sound setting can be adjusted to suit your personal preference. Select **Standard/Music/Movie/News/User** according to the program.

❖ **Treble**

Adjust to increase or decrease higher-pitched sounds.

❖ **Bass**

Adjust to increase or decrease lower-pitched sounds.

If the TV is currently in 2D mode,

- 1 Press the **3D** switch key on the remote to display the prompt menu.
- 2 Press **◀ ▶** button. You can then select a corresponding 3D mode.

If the TV is currently in 3D mode,

- 1 Press the **3D** switch key on the remote to display the prompt menu.
- 2 Press **◀ ▶** button to select 3D Mode off/2D>3D setup.

Note

- When you watch a 3D TV programme, please wear 3D glasses.

❖ **Balance**

Adjust to emphasize left or right speaker balance.

❖ **SubWoofer**

Adjust to increase or decrease subwoofer-pitched sounds.

❖ **Surround**

The surround sound feature expands the audio listening field wider and deeper to create exceptional sound quality from the TV's speakers.

❖ **Dialog Clarity**

Press ◀ ▶ button to set AVL as On or Off.(When Surround is set on, it's will appearance.)

❖ **Bass Boost**

Press ◀ ▶ button to set the SPDIF as On or Off.(When Surround is set on, it's will appearance.)

Setting Functions

- 1 Press **MENU** button.
- 2 Press ◀ ▶ button to select **Setting**, press **OK** button to enter.
- 3 Press ▲ ▼ button to select the item which require to be adjusted.
- 4 Press ◀ ▶ button to adjust the selected item.
- 5 When you are satisfied with your choice, press the **EXIT** button to return to normal viewing or press **RETURN** button to return to the previous menu.

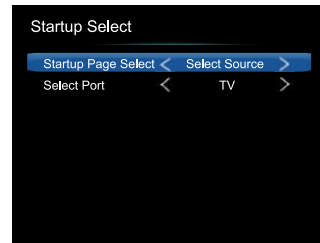
❖ **Menu Time**

Press ◀ ▶ button to select the number of minutes: To select 5s, 10s, 15s, 30s, 60s.

❖ **Startup Select**

Press ▲ ▼ button to select the Startup Select,

Press ◀ ▶ button to select Last Viewed /Navigator / Select Source.



Press ▲ ▼ button to select Select Port, press ◀ ▶ to select TV/AV/YPbPr/PC/HDMI1/HDMI2.

❖ **Reset**

Press ◀ ▶ button to select OK or Cancel to Reset Factory Set.

❖ **DNL P**


Press ◀ ▶ button to select On/Off to auto regulation contrast or brightness.

❖ **OPC**

Press ◀ ▶ button to select On/Off to set OPC.

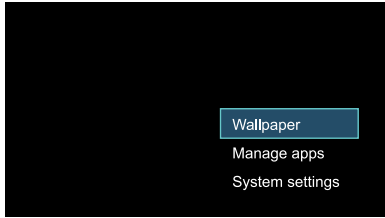
Cloud Functions

Cloud Functions

- 1 Press  button to enter Cloud interface.
- 2 Press ▲ ▼ ◀ ▶ button to select the icon which you required. Press **OK** to enter.
- 3 When you are satisfied with your choice, press **RETURN** button to return to the previous menu.



- 4 Press **MENU** button in this interface of Cloud stair menu, the OSD will display Wallpaper, Manage apps and System settings. You can press ▲ ▼ button and press **OK** button to select it.



- 5 If you want to **Exit** Cloud functions, press **Exit** button.

All Apps

- 1 Press button to enter Cloud interface.
- 2 Press button to select **ALL Apps**. Press **OK** to enter.
- 3 Press button to select the item which require to be adjusted.



The **ALL Apps** contains all functions of Cloud, you can enter this submenu for example **Settings** by **ALL Apps**.

- 4 When you are satisfied with your choice, press **RETURN** button to return to the previous menu.

Local FileBrowser

- 1 Press button to enter Cloud interface.
- 2 Press button to select **Local FileBrowser**. Press **OK** to enter.
- 3 Press button to select the **USB STORAGE-SANDISK**. Press the corresponding key on the remote control to call out the prompt menu. (See Picture below).

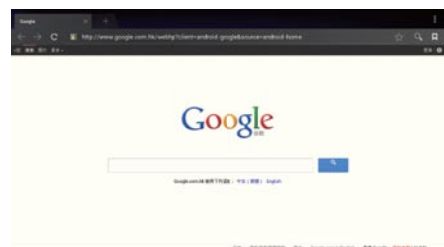

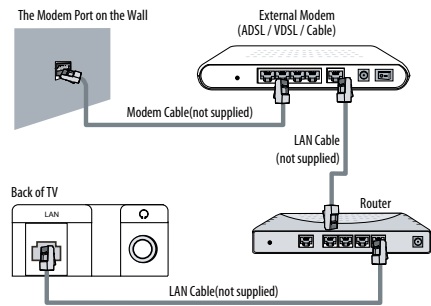
You can set up your TV to access the Internet through your local area network (LAN) using a wired or wireless connection.

Connecting to a Wired Network. You can attach your TV to your LAN using a cable (cable not included) in three ways:

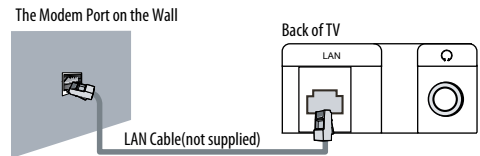
- You can attach your TV to your LAN by connecting the LAN port on the back of your TV to an external modem using a Cat 5 cable. See the diagram below:



- You can attach your TV to your LAN by connecting the LAN port on the back of your TV to a router which is connected to an external modem. Use a Cat 5 cable for the connection. See the diagram below:









- Depending on how your network is configured, you may be able to attach your TV to your LAN by connecting the LAN port on the back of your TV directly to a network wall outlet using a Cat 5 cable. See the diagram below. Note that the wall outlet is attached to a modem or router elsewhere in your house.



Note

- The terminals (the position of the port and the type) of the external device may be different depending on the manufacturer.
- If the IP address allocation by the DHCP server has failed, turn the external modem off, turn it on again after at least 10 seconds and then try again.
- For the connections between the external modem and the router, refer to the owner's manual of the corresponding product.
- You can connect the TV to the LAN directly without connecting it through a router.
- You cannot use a manual-connection-type ADSL modem because it does not support DHCP. You have to use an automatic connection-type ADSL modem.

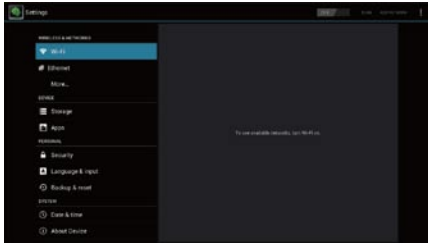

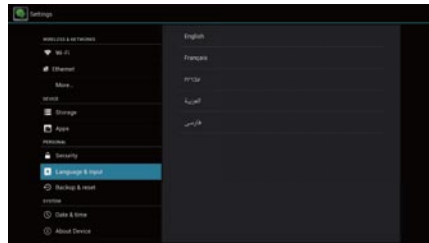

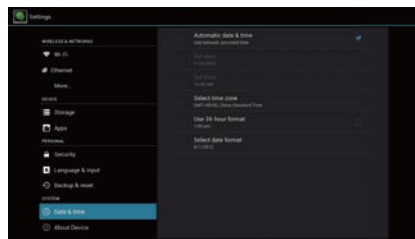

Cleaning the Cabinet

To remove dirt or dust, wipe the cabinet with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Please be sure not to use a wet cloth.

Extended Absence

If you expect to leave your TV dormant for a long time (such as a vacation), it's a good idea to unplug the power cord to protect against possible damage from lightning or power surges.
