## Base Stand Assembly Instruction

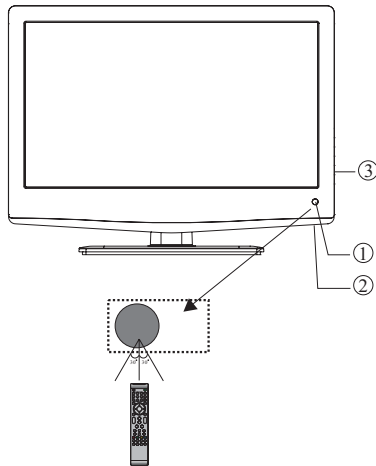
1. Place the TV with the display side down on a flat surface. Use a cloth to protect the display. Position the stand base plate onto the bottom of the stand pole.



2. Attach the stand base plate to the stand pole by firmly tightening the supplied screw.

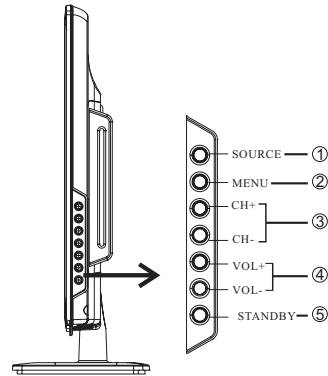

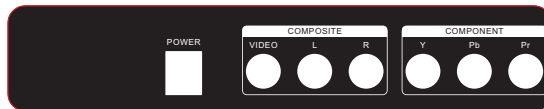
- 1: Remote control sensor.

- 1. **SOURCE:** Display the input source menu.
- 2. **MENU:** Display main MENU.
- 3. **CH+/CH-:** In TV mode, press "CH+" or "CH-" to change the channel up and down. In MENU mode, press "CH+" or "CH-" to select items in standby mode, press "CH+" or "CH-" to turn on the TV.
- 4. **VOL+/VOL-:** Adjust sound level. In MENU mode, press "VOL+ " or "VOL- " to adjust the item that you selected.
- 5. **STANDBY:** Press this button to turn the unit ON from STANDBY mode. Press it again to turn the set back to STANDBY.

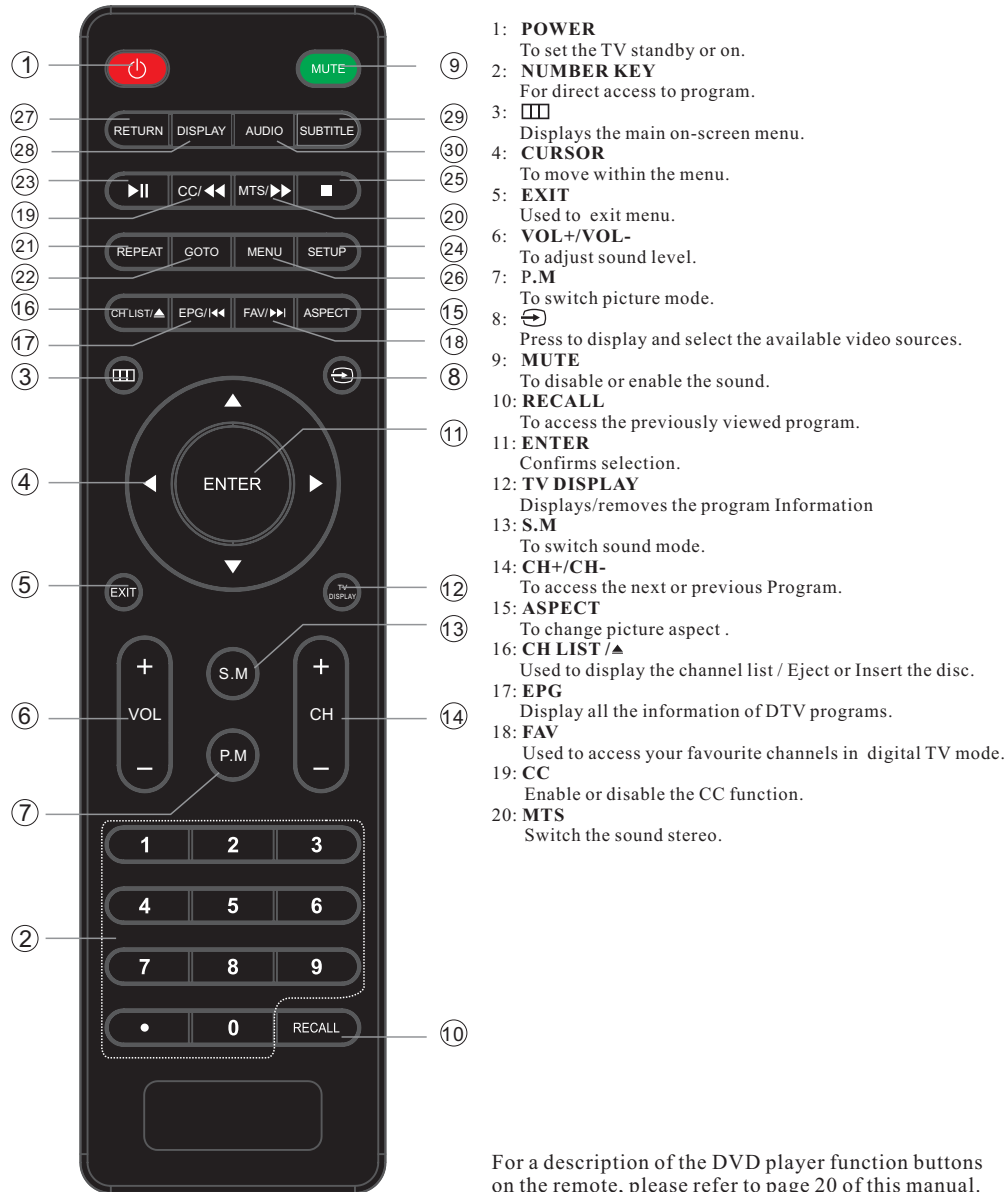
AV EQUIPMENT

## REMOTE CONTROL

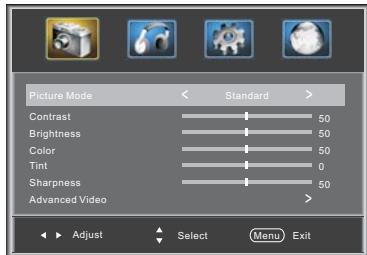

**1. PICTURE MENU**

The first item of the MENU is the PICTURE MENU. This menu provides several video adjustment options for fine tuning the video display. Press ▼▲ to select, press ◀▶ to adjust, press MENU to exit.

- 1). Picture Mode: Select the user picture mode (Standard, Sports, Movie, Custom, Vivid).
- 2). Brightness: This will adjust the light output of the complete picture, which will mainly affect the dark areas of the picture.
- 3). Contrast: This will adjust the intensity of bright parts in the picture but keep the dark parts unchanged.
- 4). Color: This will adjust the saturation level of the colors to suit your personal preference.
- 5). Tint: Allows you to select color mix (tint) of the picture.
- 6). Sharpness: This will adjust sharpness of fine details in the picture.



**Note:**  
If you want to adjust contrast, brightness, color, and sharpness, the picture mode must be set to "Custom".

**Advanced Video:**  
Press ▼▲ to select Advanced Video, press ▶, and the screen shown below will be displayed.

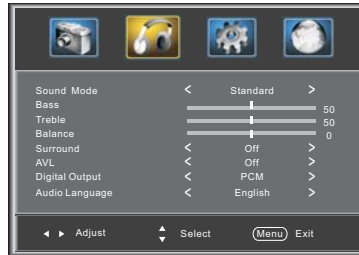
- 1). Color Temp: This will adjust color temperature (Cool, Normal, Warm) to suit your preference.
- 2). Aspect: This will vary the size of the image on the TV screen. There are four modes which can be selected (Wide, Zoom, Cinema and Normal).
- 3). Noise Reduction: Adjust to reduce the appearance of noise in the picture (dots). There are five modes to choose from (Strong, Auto, Off, Weak and Middle).



**2. AUDIO menu**

The second item of the MENU is the AUDIO MENU. You can adjust sound options here. Press ▼▲ to select, press ◀▶ to adjust, press MENU to exit.

- 1). Sound Mode: Select the user sound mode (Standard, News, Music, Theater, Sports, Custom).
- 2). Bass: Adjust to increase or decrease lower-pitched sounds.
- 3). Treble: Adjust to increase or decrease higher-pitched sounds.
- 4). Balance: Adjust to emphasize left or right speaker balance.
- 5). Surround: Turn on or off the simulated surround sound feature.
- 6). AVL: Auto Volume Level, this will reduce the differences in volume level between TV programming.
- 7). Digital Output: Select the digital sound signal that will output from the coaxial audio output.
- 8). Audio Language: Select the audio language (English, French, Spanish).



**Note:**  
The Audio language option is only available for ATSC (DTV) programs.

**3. SETUP MENU**

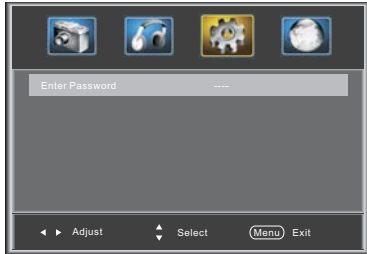
The third item of the MENU is the SETUP MENU. You can set system settings here. Press ▼▲ to select, press ◀▶ to adjust, press MENU to exit.



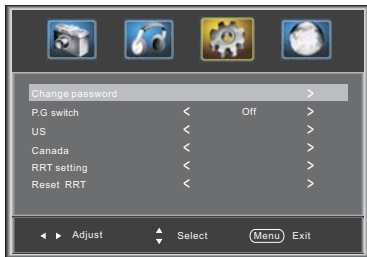

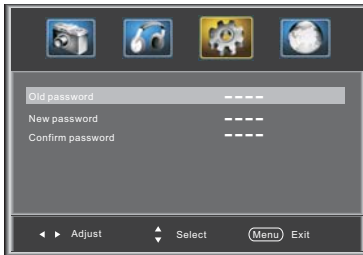

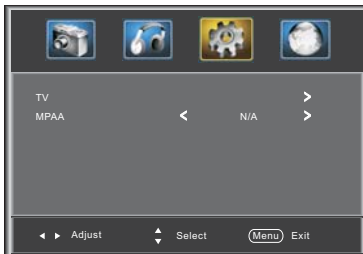

- 1): Canada English: switch the English-rating control level: EXEMPT, C, C8+, G, PG, 14+, 18+.

Rating	Description
E	Exempt: Includes news, sports, documents and other information programming; talk shows, music videos, and variety programming.
C	Children: Intended for younger children under the age of 8 years. Pays careful attention to themes that could threaten their sense of security and well-being.
C8+	Children over 8 years old: Contains no portrayal of violence as the preferred, acceptable, or only way to resolve conflict; nor encourage children to imitate dangerous acts which they may see on the screen.
G	General: Considered acceptable for all age groups. Appropriate viewing for the entire family, contains very little violence, physical, verbal or emotional.
PG	Parental Guidance: Intended for a general audience, but may not be suitable for younger children (under the age of 8) because it could contain controversial themes or issues.
14+	Over 14 Years: Could contain themes where violence is one of the dominant elements of the storyline, but it must be integral to the development of plot or character. Language usage could be profane and nudity, present within the context of the theme.

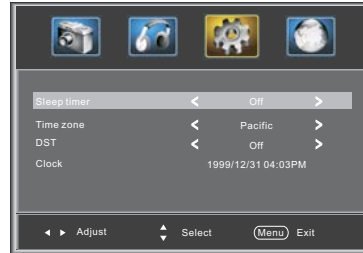

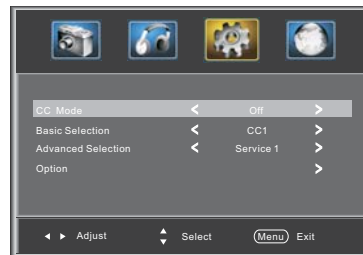

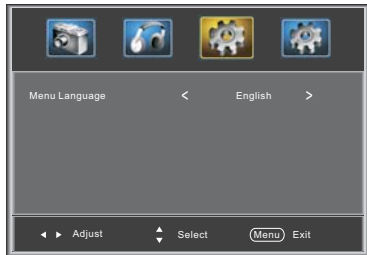

Press  $\blacktriangledown/\blacktriangle$  to select VGA Settings, press  $\blacktriangleright$ , and the screen shown below will be displayed.



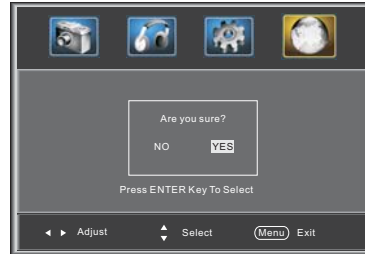
- 1). H-Pos: Adjust the horizontal position of the screen.
- 2). V-Pos: Adjust the vertical position of the screen.
- 3). Clock: Fine tune the screen width.
- 4). Phase: Fine tune the phase of the screen. Usually you don't need to adjust this item option.
- 5). Auto: Auto adjust to fit the screen.

### 4. Channel MENU

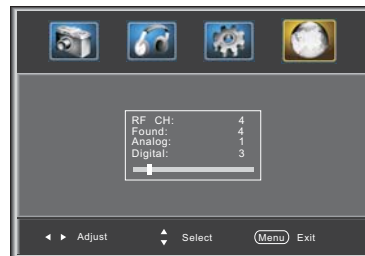
Here you add/skip TV channels and customize displayed channel info.  
Press  $\blacktriangledown/\blacktriangle$  to select, press  $\blacktriangleleft/\blacktriangleright$  to adjust.



- 1). Air/Cable: Select Air TV signal or Cable TV signal.
- 2). Auto Scan: If it's the first time using the TV, you should perform a full channel scan in order to capture and store all available channels.  
Press the  $\blacktriangleright$  to confirm, and the screen shown below will be displayed.



Select "YES" and press the **ENTER** to confirm, and the screen shown below will be displayed, which indicates that the auto search is progressing.



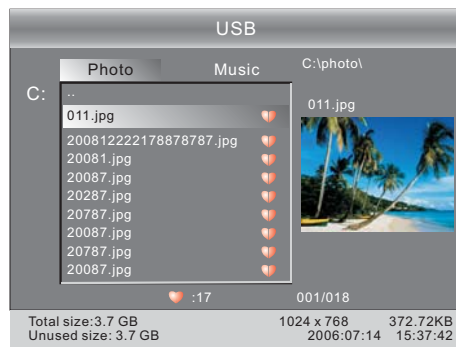
- 3). Favorite: Press  $\blacktriangleleft/\blacktriangleright$  to add/delete favorite channels.
- 4). Show/Hide: Press the ENTER button to display or hide channels.
- 5). Channel NO. : Display the current channel number. Press  $\blacktriangleleft/\blacktriangleright$  to change the channel.
- 6). Channel label: Press  $\blacktriangledown/\blacktriangle$  to edit the current channel name.
- 7). DTV signal: Display DTV signal strength.  
Signal strength indicator is for reference only, it cannot be selected or adjusted.

**5. Multimedia MENU**

With an external storage device attached to the USB input, you can use the Multimedia Menu to display JPEG pictures and play MP3 music.

Before starting operation, verify USB storage device is of FAT32 file system format. This television does not support NTFS or other formats. Please use a high-speed USB 2.0 device with a maximum capacity of 50GB.

**How to play a DVD disc**

1. Change TV input source to "DVD" mode by pressing  button on remote or Source button  on the side of the TV.

2. Place DVD disc in player with the content side (shiny side) facing the front of the unit.

3. DVD disc will automatically be loaded in to the player and begin to play.

4. To eject the DVD disc, press  Eject/Insert button on remote or the  button on the side of the unit

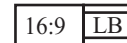

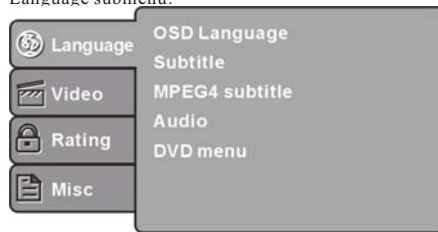

**MENU OPERATION**

Press the SETUP button on the remote control, the SETUP MENU will be displayed. After accessing the setup menu, press the direction buttons for up and down movement to select an item desired, and press RIGHT direction button to select the SUBMENU item. Then press the ENTER/OK button to confirm. Press LEFT direction button return to the menu of upper level. To exit the setup, press the SETUP button again. In the SETUP MENU, you may choose any of the following options as you like.

**LANGUAGE SETUP**

Select Language in the setup menu, and display the Language submenu:



**OSD Language**

Use this item to select the desired language for the setup menu and screen display.

**Subtitle**

This option provides the preset subtitle language.

**MPEG4 Subtitle(optional)**

Select different MPEG4 subtitle encoding option.  
**Note:** Not all players support this item.

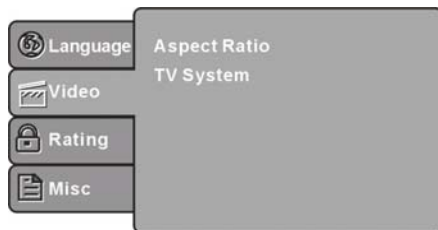
Select the built-in disc dubbing language options.

**Aspect Ratio**

**Notes:**

The image display ratio is related to the recorded disc format. Some disc can not display images in the aspect ratio you choose. If you play a disc recorded in 4:3 format on a wide screen TV, black bars will appear on the left and right side of the screen. You must adjust the screen setting depending on the type of the television you have.

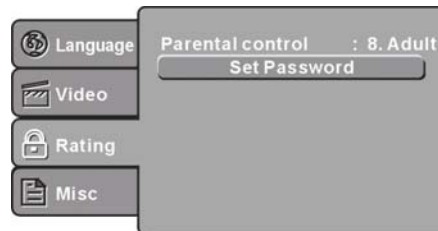

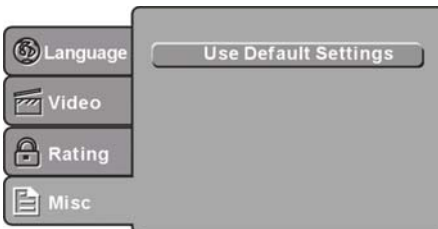

Select MISC in the setup menu, and display the submenu:




**Use Default Settings**

Reset setup data to factory default value.

**MP3/WMA/JPEG PLAYBACK**



The MP3/WMA disc has such a directory structure as shown picture above.

Press **Direction key** to choose the root directory and then press ENTER/OK button to enter into the sub directory. Press **Direction key** to choose the desired track and then press ENTER/OK or **PLAY** to enjoy the music or movie. If you want to return to the upper menu, press **Direction key** to choose  the icon and press ENTER/OK button.

**Filter:** Allows selecting the categories of files displayed in the browser list.

**Repeat:** To switch different repeat playing mode

**Mode:** Select different playing mode as follows:

**Normal:** Shuffle mode is cancelled.

**Shuffle:** Shuffle mode enabled. When playback reaches the end of the current chapter/track, playback jumps to a random chapter/track. As the end of each chapter/track is reached, another random chapter/track will be played until all tracks/chapters have been played or the Shuffle mode is cancelled by toggling to a different **Mode** Option.

**Edit Mode:** To enable programmed playback mode. When you select the mode, press **LEFT** Direction key to directory and press ENTER/OK to choose the desired track and press **Add to program** and press **Program view** and press the **Edit mode** to cancel the edit mode. At last press **Left key** to display program track and press ENTER/OK to start program playback.

**Program view:** Display program track.

**Brower view:** Display track directory.


**Add to program:** Choice the track press **Add to program** to add the track of the program play directory.

**Clear program:** In the complete stop state (press the **STOP** button twice), First press Edit mode to enable the edit mode. Press Left key to program track and press ENTER/OK to cancel the desired track. press **Clear program** to delete the track of the program play directory.

**PICTURE CD PLAYBACK**

The PICTURE CD disc has such a directory structure as shown in the following picture.



Press **Direction key** to choose the root directory and then press ENTER/OK button to enter into the sub directory. Press **Direction key** to choose the desired picture and then press ENTER/OK or **PLAY** to enjoy the picture. If you want to return to the upper menu, press **Direction key** to choose  the icon and press ENTER/OK button.

**Image rotation**

In picture play state, press **Direction key** to rotate the picture.

**Function Buttons****INSERT/EJECT ▲**

Eject the disc, press the INSERT/EJECT key; Insert the disc, press the INSERT/EJECT key again.

Insert a disc into the DVD player but could not get it to work press the INSERT/EJECT key on the remote or on the TV unit to eject the disc. When a disc is ejecting or is ejected but not take out, press the INSERT/EJECT key on the remote or on the TV unit to insert the disc.

**SUBTITLE**

Press the button to choose different captions (*Requires support from disc*)

**GOTO**

For DVD discs, press the button to choose the desired title and chapter and search the desired title time and chapter time. For Super VCD, VCD, CD discs, press this button to search the desired disc time and track time and choose the desired track.

Note: During VCD playback, the PBC mode must be set to OFF.

**0-9 keys**

These keys are used to input the time, as well as title, chapter and track numbers. When a numeric item is displayed on the screen, press the 0-9 keys to select the desired entry, and press ENTER/OK to confirm.

When a VCD is playing (with PBC off), press the 0-9 keys to select a track directly.

**MENU**

During DVD playback, press MENU to display the disc menu of the current title. During VCD/SVCD playback, press MENU to control PBC ON/OFF.

**SETUP**

Press the button to enter the system setting menu. Press the button again to exit the menu.

**RETURN**

When DVD/SVCD/VCD displaying, press RETURN button to the menu (PBC ON only).

**DISPLAY**

Press the button to show the information of the current playing disc.

**ENTER**

Press the button to confirm your choice on screen.

**REV ◀◀**

During DVD, CD MP3 or VCD playback, press REV to scan in reverse. The player will review the disc at different times speed. Press PLAY/PAUSE to resume normal playback.

**FWD ▶▶**

During DVD, CD, MP3, or VCD playback, press FWD to scan forward. The player will cue the disc at different speed. Press PLAY/PAUSE to resume normal playback.

**PREV ◀◀**

During DVD, CD, MP3, or VCD playback, press PREV to play the previous chapter, title or track.

**NEXT ▶▶**

During DVD, CD, MP3, or VCD playback, press NEXT to play the next chapter, title or track.

**STOP ■**

Press the button once and the player will be in memory stop state. Continuously press this button twice and the player will be in complete stop state.

**Play/Pause ▶||**

In pause state or stop state, press the button, the player will be in playing state. In play state, press the button the player will be in pause state.

**REPEAT**

Press to select between different repeat modes — Repeat Chapter / Repeat Title / Repeat Off (for DVD discs) , Repeat Single / Repeat Folder / All / Repeat Off (for VCD / CD / MP3 discs)

**AUDIO**

Changes the audio language or audio channel.
