
# Explanation on the display tube

Should the picture tube require cleaning, disconnect the power and use a dry soft cotton cloth. Do not use any cleaner or abrasive cloths.

# Aerial connection

For an optimum high quality picture, it is strongly advised that the TV set connect to an external aerial(s) using high quality coax cable. When connecting to HiFi VCRs, satellite (or cable) set top boxes, that the AV terminals are used to allow the stereo sound to be transferred. For optimum picture performance with satellite decodes' use a RGB ready SCART cable and set the decoder to an RGB output.

# **Battery installation**


Take off the battery compartment cover. Place two AA batteries, make sure that battery polarity matches with the +/- mark inside the battery compartment.

# Operation notes for the remote control unit


- Under normal conditions, the life time of batteries is one year.
- If you don't intend to use the unit for a long period or the electricity of the batteries is used up, remove the batteries to prevent batteries acid from leaking into the battery compartment.
- Never place batteries in a fire.
- Avoid dropping the remote control and/or getting it wet.





# Switching on/ off the TV set

1 Please press the power switch to switch on AC power supply and the power indicator will light.

2 If the indicator is lighting in red, press the button  $\bigcirc$  on the remote control again. Note:

1 When you don't operate the TV set with a remote control, you can turn on it directly through pressing the P+/- buttons on the TV set (Child Lock must be turned off).

2 If you want to exchange to standby status,

please press down the button  $\bigcirc$  on the remote control.

3 If you want to fully switch off the power supply for the TV set, please press the power switch button on the TV set.

# Auto switch-off function


When the "Back" function is on, if an empty channel is selected or the TV programs are ended for the day, the power will be switched off 5 minutes later automatically. If the "OFF TIME" is on, it will be switched off according to the presetting time. The auto power off function does not work under video input or when the background is off.


(Note: If the "off timer" is less than 5 minutes, it will be switched off automatically to the preset Time. )



# How to select TV program

Select the desired program

- 1 Using "Program number" buttons
- Directly enter the channel number with the numeric keypad on the remote control.
- To select channel numbers from 10 ~99 press [-/--] button and enter the two digit channel number To select channel numbers from 100 ~218 press [-/--] button
- twice and enter the 3 digit channel number
- 2 Using the CH+/- buttons
- Press the CH+ button to select a channel number in number increasing direction.
- Press the CH- button to select a channel number in number decreasing direction.

Select the desired sound

Press the VOL-/+ buttons on the remote or the front of the TV set to adjust the volume level. The range is 0~99. When the volume buttons are pressed the volume level is displayed automatically on the TV screen.

# If the colour or sound of a channel is abnormal

Usually this should be set in the Auto position. Howeverif the colours displayed on the screen are incorrect you can manually select the correct colour system. When finish remember to turn it back to auto again so that other programs will still work correctly. To select the colour change option press the TUNE button on the remote control.



• If picture colour is abnormal

Use the CH+/- buttons to select Colour then the VOL-/+ buttons to change between Auto, PAL, NTSC, SECAM and NTSC443. Press the EXIT button to save the setting.


 If the picture sound is abnormal Use the CH+/- buttons to select Sound then press the VOL-/+ buttons to select the sound system.
 (In general, DK, BG will display in turn.)


- Swap function enables quick swap to the last watched program.
- Auto scan function enables automatic successive scanning of all the programs in memory with "OFF" skip status (each channel will last about 2 seconds).

# How to select picture modes

You can quickly select the desired picture mode from four preset modes and one customized mode.

Press the P.STD button to select the

desired picture quality. Five kinds

of picture modes (i.e., "STANDARD",

"RICH", "USER", "LISTEN",

"SOFT" ) can be selected in turn.

The 5 modes are

Listen-This is a new feature that blacks out the TV screen when listening to music only channels;

Soft-Designed for night time low light viewing;

Standard -Designed for rooms that have good all round lighting;

Rich-Designed for rooms with high ambient lighting such as daytime sport;

User-A spare setting that can be adjusted to personal tastes.












# How to choose sound mode

Press the S.STD button to select the desired sound quality. There are 4 sound modes (i.e., "THEATER", "MUSIC", "USER" and "SPEECH") can be selected in turn.



The 4 modes are:

Speech-Designed to reduce the bass and treble which enhances the voice for news programs:

Theatre-Enables extra bass and treble to enhance the movie experience;

Music-Adjust the sound to best suit music programs; User - Aspare setting that can be adjust to personal tastes.



3 Press the CH+/- buttons select WOOFER VOL, then press the VOL-/+ buttons to obtain the desired effect.



# Clock setting

The clock will only work if the TV set if left turned on or in standby. When the set is disconnect from the power supply or is turned off by the main power on the front panel, the clock loses power and will need to be reset when the power is reconnected.

1 Press the TIME menu button and the TIME menu display on the screen.

2Press the CH+/- buttons select "CLOCK", then press the VOL -/+ buttons to adjust the time in hour position; press again the CH+/- buttons to select the time in minute position, then press the VOL -/ +buttons to adjust the value of minutes .



# On/off timer

Using on/off timer function, the TV set can automatically turn on to a preset program or shut down in a preset time.

1 Press the TIME menu button to call up the TIME menu on the screen.


2 Press the CH+/- buttons to select "ON TIME", then press the VOL -/+ buttons to set the value in hour position; press again the CH+/- buttons to select the minute position and set the value of the minute.(take 18:00 as an example)

3 Press the CH+/- buttons to select "ON PROG", then press the VOL-/+ or program direct number buttons to select your desired channel (take 8 as an example).

4 Repeat step 1-2 to set OFF TIME.(take 23:00 as an example)

# Teletext

• Teletext is an information system, broadcast by certain channels, which can be read like a newspaper . It also provides subtitles for people with hearing difficulties or those who are unfamiliar with the language in which a particular program is being broadcast (cable networks, satellite channels, etc.).

# Teletext functions

You can press TELETEXT button into TELETEXT mode, press again to leave TELETEXT mode. All menu related functions are not available in TELETEXT mode. Only a few direct button control functions are available in TELETEXT mode, they are:

- Volume adjustment, but without OSD display.
- Mute function, but without OSD display.



# Cancel mode

This feature allows the TV picture to be displayed while next page to be searched is entered and found. Only the top teletext line is displayed until the page is found. Press the button to hide the teletext information. Either press the  $\boxtimes$  button or the Text button to exit the cancel display mode.

Press the  $\equiv$  button on the remote control to turn teletext On/Off.

# Subtitle

Pressing the  $\Box$  button will get the teletext decoder to automatically search for the subtitle page. In NZ the subtitle is usually page 801.


# Fast text coloured buttons

Fast text automatically displays the four most commonly used pages that the broadcaster thinks that you may want to choose next. Press the same coloured button on the remote control as the coloured link at the bottom of the teletext page to go directly to that page.

# Connecting to the other video and audio equipment

You can connect a stereo to the AUDIO output terminals on the TV set to enjoy higher quality sound. VIDEO and AUDIO output terminals output the video and audio signals being monitored by the TV set. The electric levels of video and audio output signals are fixed.

1.If the fault can not be repaired using the above guide consult with your local authorized service center.

2.The TV set must only be repaired by a qualified registered service person. Never attempt to remove the back cover as the TV set has dangerous voltages in side that may cause a fatally or fire.
 The cabinet may produce the occasional "snapping sound" This is normal and caused by the materials in the cabinet expanding with room temperature changes.
