Battery Replacement

- Your Micro Personal Player comes with batteries already installed.
- To replace batteries, unscrew battery door lock
- 3. Remove exhausted batteries and dispose of properly. Insert 3 new LR44/G13A
- type Button Batteries. Replace battery door and tighten screw.



To ensure proper function Do not mix old and new batteries.

- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon zinc), or rechargeable batteries (nickel-cadmium). Battery installation should be done by an adult. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be
